- To register with the Independent Schools Association for links with other schools, for support through cluster meetings and for future Ofsted inspections



## **Trust Objectives this year**

- To support the Head teacher to allow us to go from a 'requires improvement' grading to a 'good school' grading as identified by Ofsted.
- To continue to work on our Quran curriculum, amending, developing and refining it as required
- To bring in intensive training for our Quran teachers, working with other organisations and individuals, to facilitate this



### **Trust objectives next year**

- Ongoing raising funds to purchase our own building
- Increasing our Hifdh provision for children in Y4 or 5 to Y6, allowing some children to access a more intensive memorisation programme
- Continue to focus on Whole Child Development through new initiatives, such as:
  - ✤ Introducing other types of teaching, such as Forest School
  - To look at developments in education that are proving to be of great benefit to children's speaking and reasoning skills, such as philosophy



## Trust objectives next year

- Other initiatives to benefit the community, such as:
  - Adult Education classes such as Tajweed and Parenting classes
  - Mother and toddler classes with basic Montessori style teaching methods and the philosophy behind it being taught
  - ✤ Working on opening a Quran teacher training college.
