## A WORD FROM THE GENERAL DIRECTOR

**I was reminded recently that we seem to have an inbuilt human tendency to think that we are valued by the Lord according to what we are able to do for Him.** We then either proudly judge that we are more capable than others or come to the conclusion that we are of little value compared to those who appear to have more to give. Both, of course, are equally unhealthy responses.

Writing in 2 Corinthians chapter 8, the apostle Paul commends qualities evident in the churches of Macedonia as they sought to serve the Lord by sending a relief offering to the persecuted and famine-stricken believers in Judea.

In verse 5 we read that *'they first gave themselves'* to the Lord. They recognised that their act of service would be of little eternal value if they had not made **a priority of giving themselves personally** to Him. These followers of Christ had learned that God is looking

for yielded vessels He can use rather than the restricted channels caused by falsely placed confidence in our natural abilities.

According to verse 2 these Macedonian Christians had *'given out of their poverty'*. They themselves were going through a time of great affliction and naturally speaking they had little or perhaps nothing to give. Yet in response to the burden God had put on their hearts they had given out of their poverty. In keeping with a proven scriptural principle, God had taken the little they had to offer and multiplied it to bless the churches of Judea in their time of need.

Another mark of their confident trust in and complete surrender to the Lord was that they gave **unreservedly**. In verse 3 Paul says: *'For I bear witness that according to their ability, yes, and beyond their ability they were freely willing'*. They had embraced the grace of

giving of themselves and their substance cheerfully and without restraint.

The final quality Paul tells us about these servants of the Lord is that they gave themselves **unitedly**. He emphasises this by speaking about *'their joy', 'their poverty'* and *'their ability'*; he also points out that *'they were freely willing'* and *'this they did'*. The psalmist reminds us in Psalm 133 that we can confidently expect to know God's blessing when we as His people live and serve together in unstrained unity.

As we approach another Christmas season, followed by the beginning of a new year, let us make it our **priority** to give ourselves to Him **personally, unreservedly and in unity** recognising our great **poverty** but trusting in His mighty, multiplying and unfailing grace. After all, *'He loved us and gave Himself for us'*.

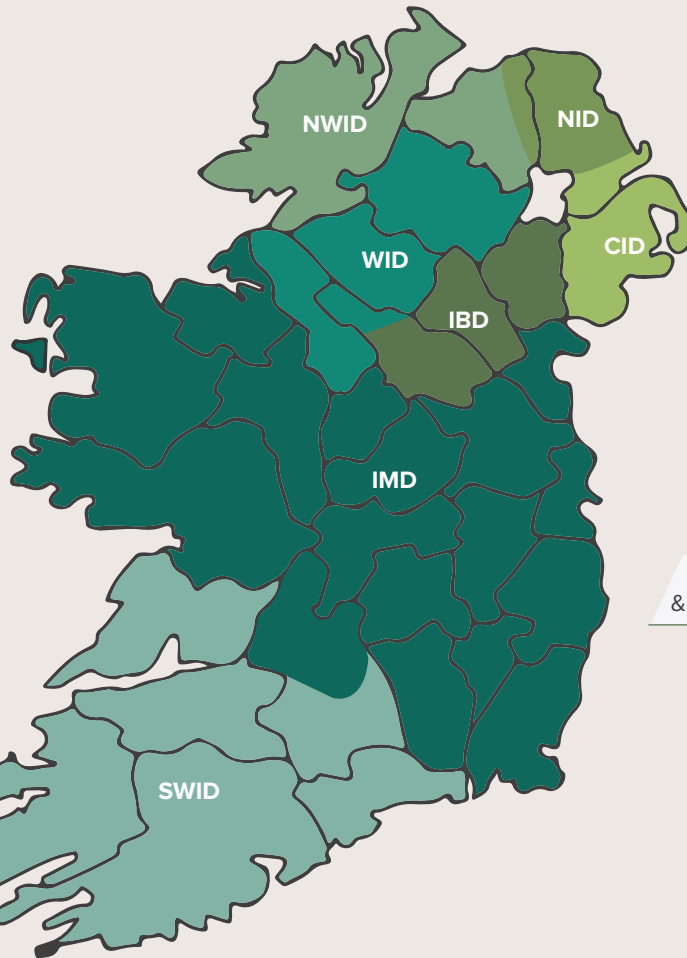

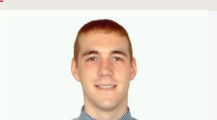
