With nearly half of Uganda's population under the age of 14, the average age of its citizens is the lowest of any nation in the world. ACTION is reaching out to many of these young lives.

Spain, was the now-closed El Bulli restaurant. When it was still open, it was so popular that customers had to make reservations six months in advance. The noted chef and owner Ferran Adriá once closed the doors of his restaurant for two years to think, plan, and innovate with his staff. In an interview with *Hemispheres* magazine, Adriá commented, "If we are winning all the prizes, why change? Well, working 15 hours a day leaves us little time to create." He realized that it was important to take time out to formulate new plans.¹

The book of Acts tells the story of the dramatic growth of the early church. What was behind this exciting growth? One important factor was periods of prayer to understand God's plan. Paul and his associates were planning to enter the province of Asia, but they stopped to seek the Lord's direction. A

vision came to Paul during the night in which a man said to him, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." As a result of this spiritual encounter, a church was soon planted in the Greek city of Philippi (Acts 16).
