HOUSE BILL No. 4478

April 18, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Steven Johnson, Slagh, Calley and Yaroch and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 407, entitled "Skilled trades regulation act,"

by amending sections 1111 and 1123 (MCL 339.6111 and 339.6123).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1111. (1) To qualify for a plumbing contractor license,
- 2 the applicant must either hold a master plumber license or employ
- 3 the holder of a master plumber license as his or her
- 4 representative.
- 5 (2) Only an individual who is a sole proprietor, a partner in
- 6 a partnership, an officer of a corporation, or a member of a
 - limited liability company may apply for licensure as a plumbing
- 8 contractor.
 - (3) The department shall issue a plumbing contractor's license
- 10 to an individual who does all of the following:

- 1 (a) Files a completed application on a form provided by the
- 2 department that includes the following information:
- 3 (i) A statement listing the complete address of each place
- 4 where the applicant has resided and has been engaged in business
- 5 during the last 5 years including the length of time at each
- 6 residence and types of businesses engaged in or employments. IF THE
- 7 APPLICANT IS REGISTERED AS A PLUMBING INSPECTOR UNDER ARTICLE 10
- 8 AND ENGAGED IN BUSINESS AS A PLUMBING CONTRACTOR, THE STATEMENT
- 9 MUST ALSO INCLUDE THAT ADDRESS.
- 10 (ii) The name of the individual who is applying for the
- 11 license, the name of the business, and the location of the place
- 12 for which the license is desired.
- 13 (iii) The name of the business owner, president of the
- 14 corporation, or a member or manager of the limited liability
- 15 company and the name of the individual who is applying, if
- 16 different from the name of the business owner, president, or member
- 17 or manager and his or her title.
- 18 (iv) The name, residence address, and license number of the
- 19 licensed master plumber who represents the person.
- 20 (b) Pays the applicable examination fee established under
- 21 section 207 and passes an examination provided for by the board and
- 22 the department.
- (c) Pays the license fee described in article 4.
- 24 (4) A licensed plumbing contractor may operate 1 or more
- 25 branch offices in this state under the same business if a licensed
- 26 master plumber is in charge and has the responsibility of
- 27 supervision at each branch.

- 1 (5) If a license is issued to a plumbing contractor
- 2 represented by a master plumber, the plumbing contractor and the
- 3 master plumber are jointly and severally responsible for exercising
- 4 the supervision or control of the plumbing operations necessary to
- 5 secure full compliance with this article, the rules promulgated
- 6 under this article, and all other laws and rules related to the
- 7 installation of plumbing.
- 8 (6) Both a person, unless the person is a plumbing contractor,
- 9 and the master plumber are jointly and severally responsible for
- 10 exercising the supervision or control of the plumbing operations
- 11 necessary to secure full compliance with this article, the rules
- 12 promulgated under this article, and all other laws and rules
- 13 related to the installation of plumbing.
- 14 (7) If a plumbing contractor is represented by a licensed
- 15 master plumber who ceases to represent the plumbing contractor, the
- 16 plumbing contractor has 30 days after the date the master plumber
- 17 no longer represents the plumbing contractor in which to designate
- 18 another licensed master plumber as the representative of the
- 19 plumbing contractor. The plumbing contractor shall notify the
- 20 department in writing of the change.
- 21 (8) A licensed plumbing contractor shall display in a
- 22 conspicuous place at the entrance of the place of business a sign
- 23 that states the name of the business and the name of the licensed
- 24 master plumber and license number in letters that are at least 3
- 25 inches high.
- Sec. 1123. An individual who is licensed under this article
- 27 and employed or acting IS REGISTERED UNDER ARTICLE 10 as a plumbing

- 1 inspector shall not engage in, or be directly or indirectly
- 2 connected with, the plumbing business, including, but not limited
- 3 to, the furnishing of labor, materials, or appliances for the
- 4 construction, alteration, or maintenance of a building or the
- 5 preparation of plans or specifications for the construction,
- 6 alteration, or maintenance of a building, and shall not engage in
- 7 any work that conflicts with his or her official duties. IS NOT
- 8 PROHIBITED FROM ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF PLUMBING.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 10 after the date it is enacted into law.
