Nomination & Election of 2020 SAAZ Officers

Per to the current bylaws, **the election is held at the December meeting** (usually the Christmas Party, which is why we hope to change this in the bylaws for next year). Nominations are now open. Submit in person at the Nov meeting or via email to secretary@saaz.org AND president@saaz.org (copy both). You may nominate someone else with their permission or self-nominate.

We are looking to fill a number of the positions. Some of the current officers have personal commitments that are requiring them to step down for the next year and others have already served multiple terms in their current position, so we're eager to have some enthusiastic members take an interest in joining the group that will lead the club over the next year. Don't be shy... it's a team effort and we'll help transition any new board members. Board members are expected to attend monthly board meetings (which always include food and beer, of course) and to attend most SAAZ activities, though we understand that everyone can't always make them all.

Read through the board position descriptions and responsibilities in the current bylaws and in the new proposed bylaws (that way, you're prepared whether the changes are ratified or not). Also feel free to talk with current board members to get a feel for what's involved. We'll be electing the following positions: President, Vice President (who also serves as CSAAZ Event Coordinator), Events Coordinator, Secretary/Membership Coordinator, Treasurer, Communications Coordinator (website/newsletter/social media/promotion), Education Coordinator/Historian, SAAZ Ambassador (sponsorship relations/donations). Remember that you don't need to do everything related to a position all by yourself... forming committees and delegation is both allowed and encouraged!

Homebrew Con 2020: June 18-20 in Nashville
