## About “AZIZA”

**Discover this state-of-the-art, fully featured and multi-usable Wordpress theme, suitable for all business purposes.**

Aziza is built on our solid TD-framework, suitable for using child themes, and already prepared for Woocommerce, bbPress, WPML, and contact form plugins Gravity and Contact 7. Install and activate the plugins, (the LayerSlider WP plugin is already built-in, and only needs to be activated), and together with Aziza's dummy content you're ready to go before you know it! Aziza comes with an extended and premium TD-Shortcode plugin, which includes 175+ amazing shortcodes, built to the latest marketplace 'quality standards'.

Aziza has four different slider options, default pages, full width pages and blank templates for a building a home intro page, maintenance page or otherwise. Aziza introduces TD-folio for creating portfolios, including footer tabs for adding additional and extra information besides (custom) sidebars and (custom) footer widgets. This theme simply has too much features to mention!

# **AZIZA Technical Manual – Features and tools**

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# 01. How to install the theme files and plugins.

After purchasing theme AZIZA, your download contains a zip-file with the file name “AZIZA – unzip me please”.

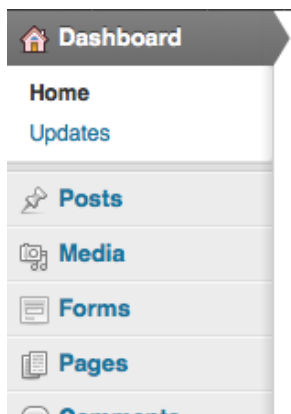
1. Unzip the downloaded AZIZA zip-file and extract it to any local directory on your computer.
2. Navigate to, and open the unzipped folder. You’ll find 3 zipped folders, a LICENCING FOLDER and one READ ME! File.
3. You can either extract and copy the unzipped AZIZA folder directly into your WP\_THEMES FOLDER on your site, or alternatively install the zip through the Wordpress ‘INSTALL THEMES’ PANEL (instructions below).

## Install the Theme.

You can install the AZIZA theme using several methods. We use the easiest and fastest approach though, and this is via your Wordpress dashboard.

1. Access your Wordpress account, and login.

Once you’ve logged in, you’ll be directed to the dashboard.



2. Go to **Appearance** and click **Themes**.



3. Click the **Install Themes** tab.



4. Next, hit **Upload**.



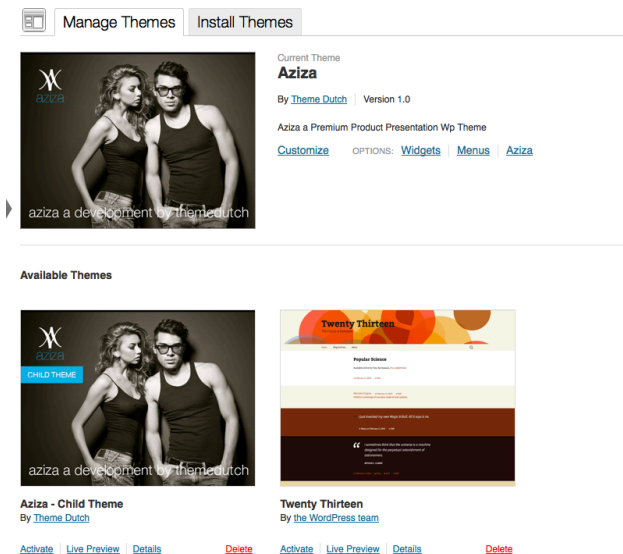
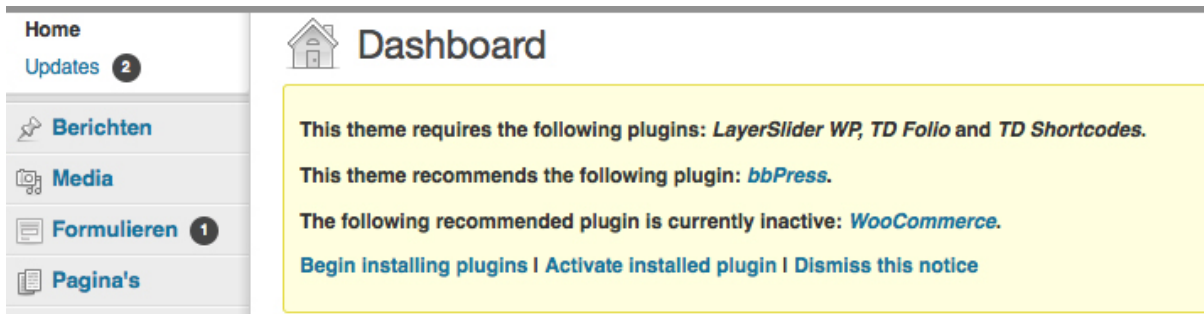
5. Still remember the AZIZA folder you zipped earlier? Click the Browse button, locate the said AZIZA zipped folder and then select it.

6. Click **Install Now**.

7. Wait for the installation to finish and then hit **Activate** link. Then you'll see this screen.

**NOTE:**

**Theme AZIZA is now activated. Read these following messages, which appear on your dashboard carefully, because they provide important info about “required and recommended plugins” for theme AZIZA. You’ll have to upload, install and activate the plugins: Woocommerce, bbPress, and WPML. The LayerSlider WP plugin is built-in, and only needs to be activated.**



## 02. How to install dummy content.

Installing Dummy content sometimes can cause difficulties. We try to explain the steps you need to take as clearly as possible though. This way you receive almost an exact copy of the preview website.

If you use Woocommerce, install the Woocommerce plugin 'before' you upload dummy content. Wordpress will give an error uploading products before Woocommerce is installed.

Unzip the included file: 'Aziza Dummy' and you will find the following:

Aziza\_wp\_options.sql  
Aziza\_dummy-content.xml  
Aziza-import-layersliderwp.txt

### **STEP 1 – The Content**

Go to Tools > Import; then select "WordPress".

You need to install the Wordpress installer Plugin.

Browse for the dummy-content.xml (inside aziza dummy) and click "Upload file and import"

#### **Step 1-a:**

Please select the "Download and import file attachments" and then click submit.

#### **Step 1-b:**

Once the import is done, it will prompt you an error "Failed to import media filename.jpg". Please don't panic. Everything is in order. This is something from wordpress, which we don't control. (Wordpress version wp 3.7)

### **STEP 2 – Most theme settings**

2-1 Go to your phpMyAdmin from your Hosting provider, and browse to wp\_options inside your database tables.

2-2 Click import and browse for the wp\_options.sql file.

### **STEP 3 – Import the Aziza sliders** made with the Layer slider.

3-1 Copy the content from: Aziza-import-layersliderwp.txt

3-2 Go to the backend and look for Layerslider WP in the main dashboard.

3-3 Use the Import sliders feature and hit import.

### **STEP 4**

Go via your WordPress Dashboard to Settings and click Reading. At the first item, "Front page displays", you have to select a static page, and then select which page should become your homepage (for example, "Home" the in the drop down menu)

### **Voila**

Your website will Look for 99% exact like our preview website, Except for the sidebar widgets. You HAVE to create your own sidebars and insert the widgets of your choice to be display in those areas.

### **NOTE!**

Please note that the images are copyright protected and only can to be used as a demo. You need to remove all images from your media uploader.

### **Local, subdomain or subdirectory install**

*Known issues for step 1-c:*

If you're WP install is in a subdomain or a subdirectory, you need to do 'a search and replace' in the dummy-content.xml. You will have to look for "/wp-content/uploads/dummy/" and replace it with "http://subdomain.domain.com/wp-content/uploads/dummy/" or "http://domain.com/subdirectory/wp-content/uploads/dummy/"

### **Installation issues**

Some servers not allow importing dummy content. This can be caused by different reasons (such as your servers settings), and which we cannot control.

We do not provide free support on installation issues, which are caused by servers and/or settings. Every server has its own methods and settings, and it might take some hours before the problem has been found. If you face these issues, please check our forums first in order to learn if this a more common issue.

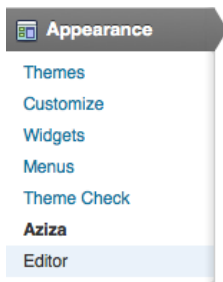
If the process, as described above, is too difficult for you, you can make use of our installation plans via our website. We can install your dummy content and even might contact your hosting provider.

### 03. AZIZA Admin Panel – Theme settings AZIZA

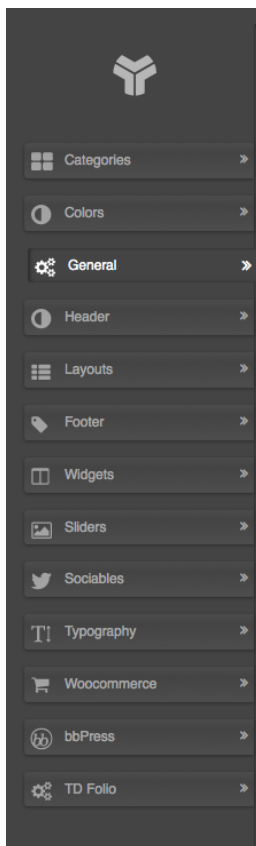
The AZIZA Admin panel is one of AZIZA’s most useful and powerful tools. Besides the regular WP features, It contains almost ‘all the theme’s controls, settings, options and functionalities’.

**TIP:** If you’re using theme AZIZA for the first time, theme, we strongly advice to concentrate on the Admin Panel first, and learn all about its options.

To access Aziza’s Admin Panel, go to the **Appearance** menu and select **AZIZA**.



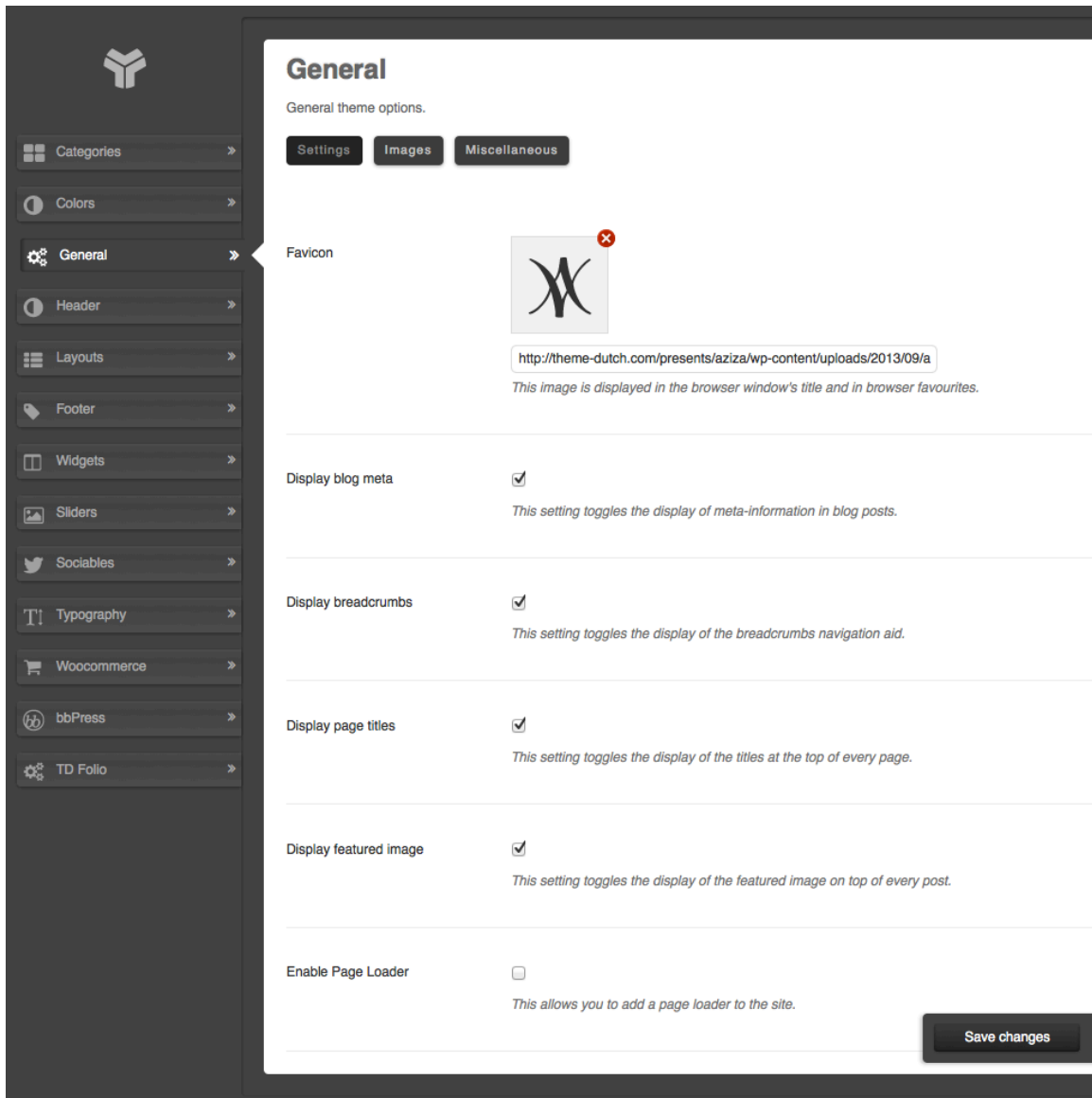
The AZIZA Admin Panel contains ‘settings for most of the theme’s features’. The default tab is **General**. In here, you can change/set the general settings of the theme.



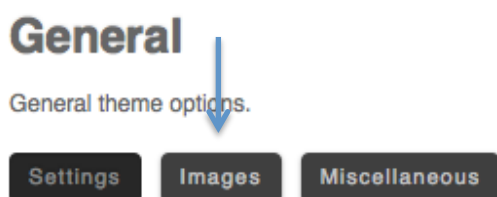


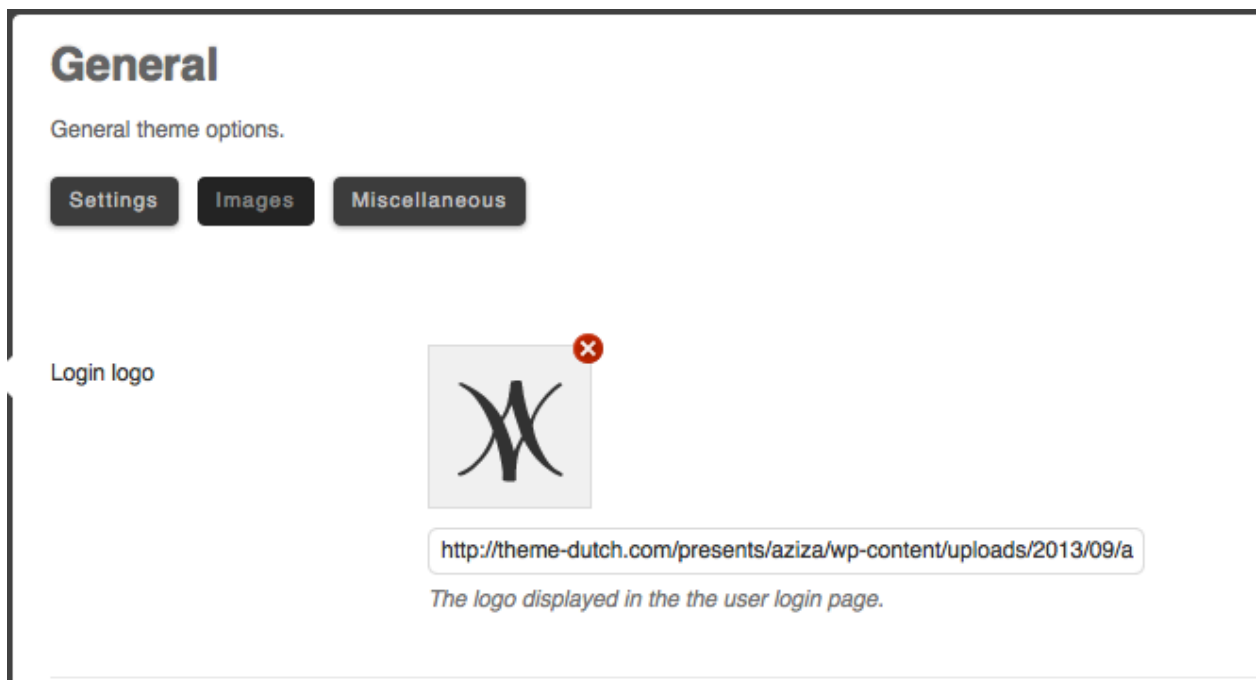
## 04. Aziza Admin panel – Theme settings Aziza

Lets start with the **General 'Settings'** section tab. In this section, you can tick and adjust theme options you want to enable and tick the ones you want to disable. All settings are self-explanatory. Hit the **Save changes** button when you're done.

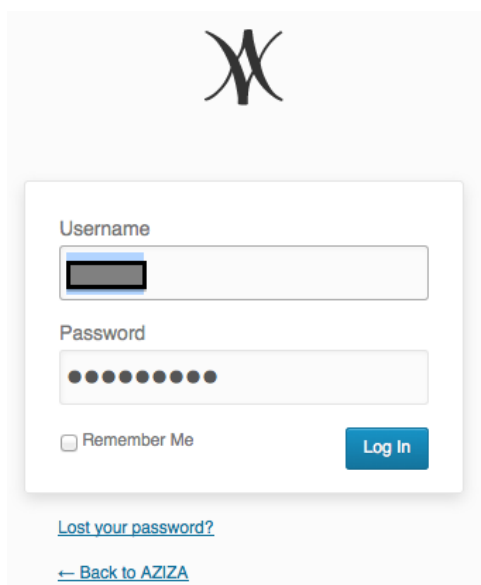


The next section is General **'Images'**. In here, you can set the logo (image) that needs to be displayed in the user login page.





Hit the **Save changes** button when you're done.



When it's saved, your website will now have your new logo displayed on the login area.

The next section is General '**Miscellaneous**'. This General Miscellaneous tab lets you add more customized codes to your theme. Here you can disable the packaged SEO Basics for AZIZA. But be careful, though. You should tick this option if you've already installed other third-party Wordpress SEO plugins.

## 05. Aziza Admin panel - Categories

The Categories module makes it possible to set the design layouts for each of your added categories. To know more about how to add categories in Wordpress, please click this link: <http://en.support.wordpress.com/posts/categories>.

Example categories AZIZA:

**Add New Category**

Name:

The name is how it appears on your site.

Slug:

The "slug" is the URL-friendly version of the name. It is usually all lowercase and contains only letters, numbers, and hyphens.

Parent:

Categories, unlike tags, can have a hierarchy. You might have a Jazz category, and under that have children categories for Bebop and Big Band. Totally optional.

Description:

The description is not prominent by default; however, some themes may show it.

**Note:**  
Deleting a category does not delete the posts in that category. Instead, posts that were only assigned to it are set to the category **Uncategorized**.  
Categories can be selectively converted to tags using the [category to tag converter](#).

To access the **AZIZA Admin panel Categories**, go to Appearance > AZIZA > Categories. Provided you've already added categories to your site, you can see here several categories with their corresponding layouts, sliders, thumbnails, backgrounds, color schemes, slogan blocks, Meta descriptions and Meta keywords.

For this example, we want to change the design layout of the Category: **Blog Sidebar Right**. You'll have to do this:

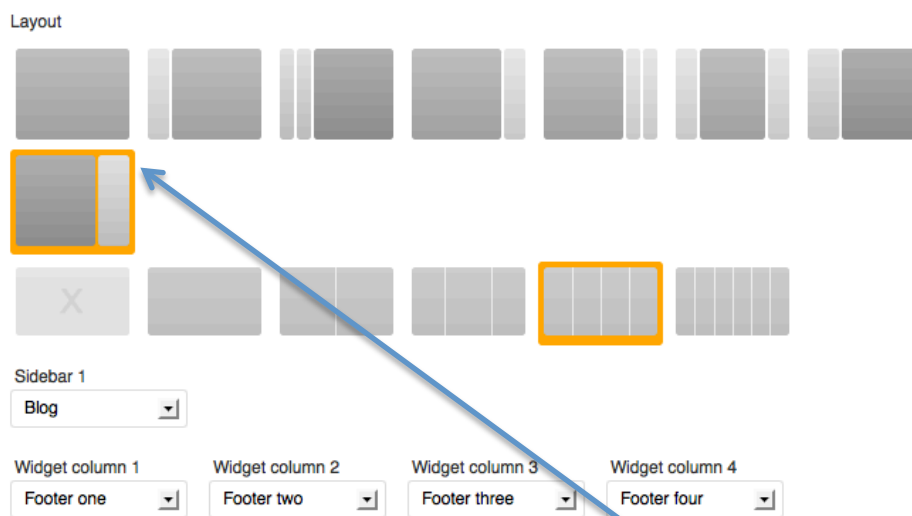
1. Click the category you want to change.
2. Select the category's Layout scheme. The first option would be to set the page

layouts. You have 8 page layout options (with or without sidebar(s)), and 6 footer layout options (with or without sidebar(s), to choose from.

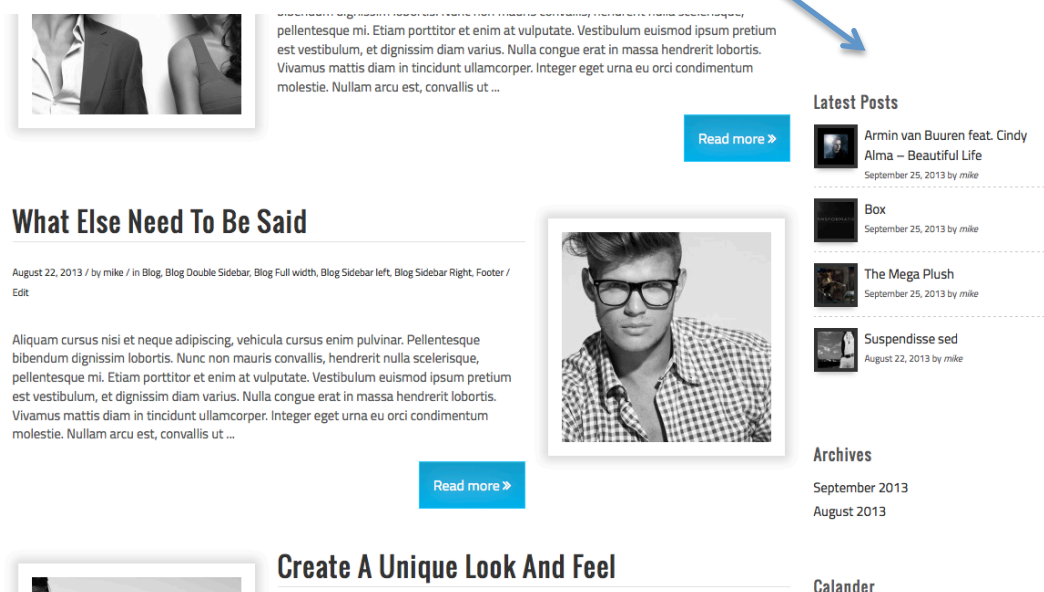
For this illustration, we chose a page-layout with a **sidebar right**, including a **four-column footer** layout. We selected the widget 'Blog', from our available widget in the scroll down menu. (Which appears if you select a sidebar page layout). The widgets for this sidebar we've already created in the section 'Widgets' at the Aziza Admin panel. For this illustration, we chose a footer-layout including a four-column layout. We've already created footer widgets. (Footer one, Footer 2, Footer 3, and Footer 4.)

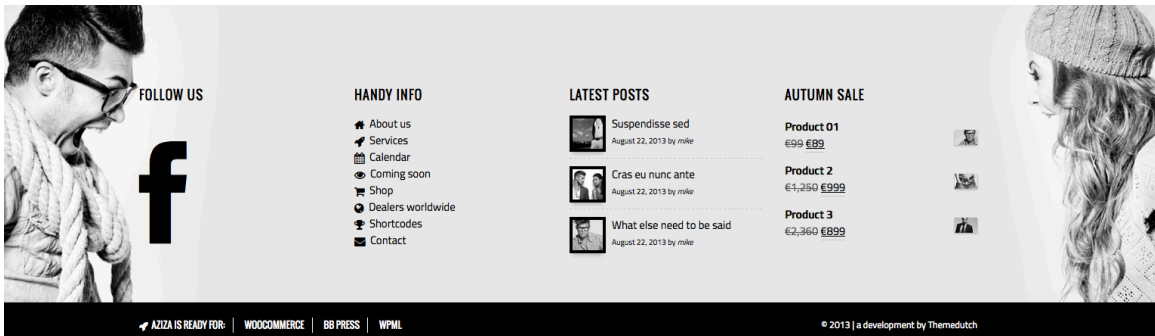

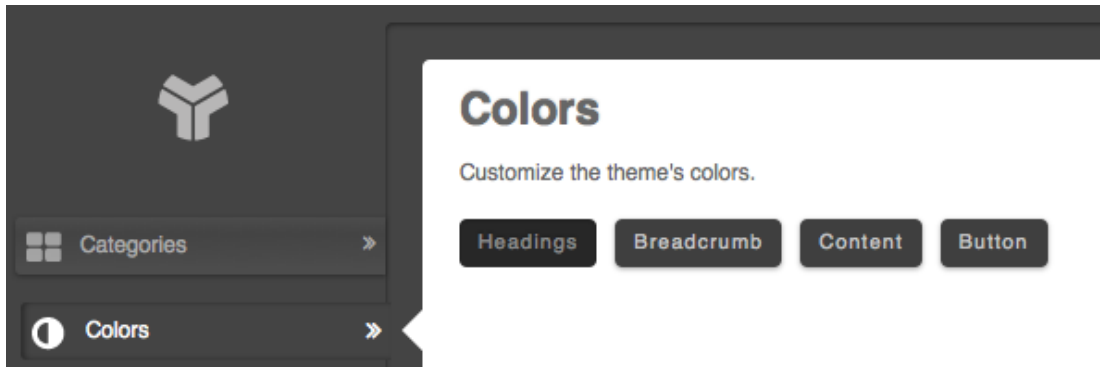

## 06. Aziza Admin panel - Colors

In this Module, you can change or set the theme's colors. You can customize the theme's **Headings, Menu, Breadcrumbs, Sidebar, Footer, Content and Portfolio** colors.

For this illustration, we will modify the button colors.



1. Click **Button**

2. You can change the colors in two ways.

The first method is by manually inputting the HTML color codes to the provided text boxes.



The second method is by clicking the box highlighted below, and dragging the color selector tool to your desired hue.

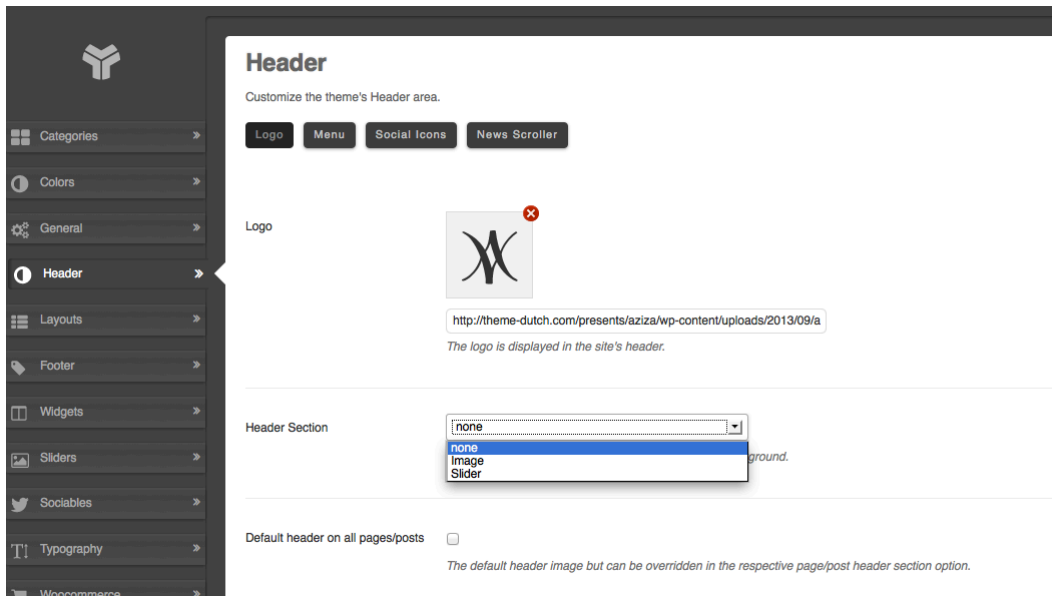


3. When you're done setting the colors, hit the **Save changes** button.

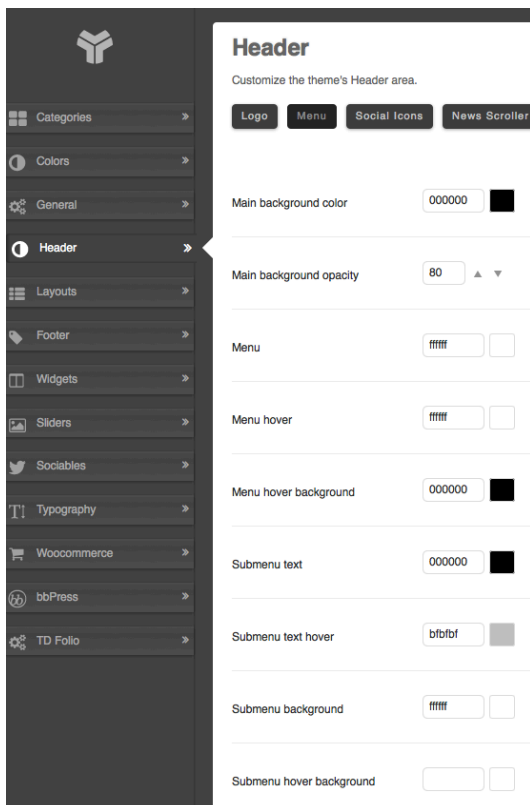
## 07. Aziza Admin panel - Header

This section allows customizing the theme's Header area. All settings are self-explanatory. Additional info is provided beneath the boxes though.

Logo: choose logo + image, slider, or nothing in the header area.

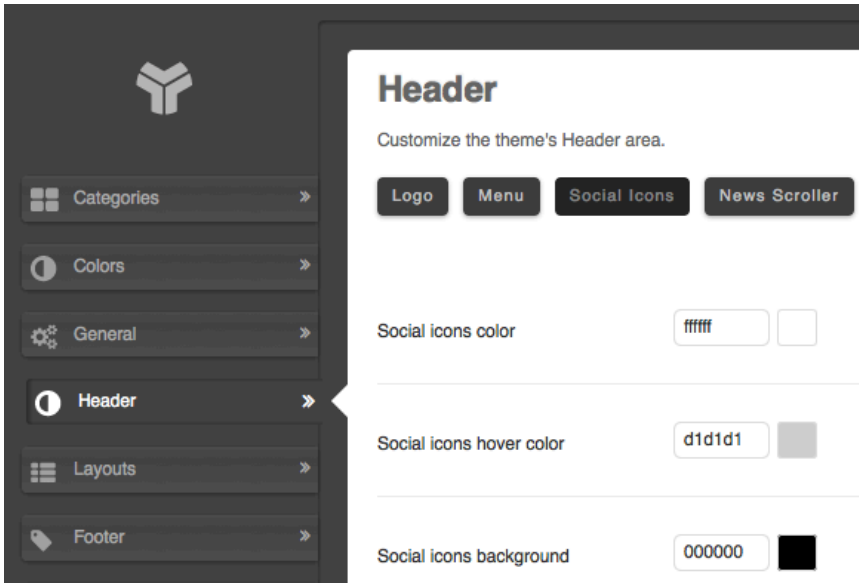


Menu: select colors (already explained in chapter 05. Aziza Admin panel: colors)

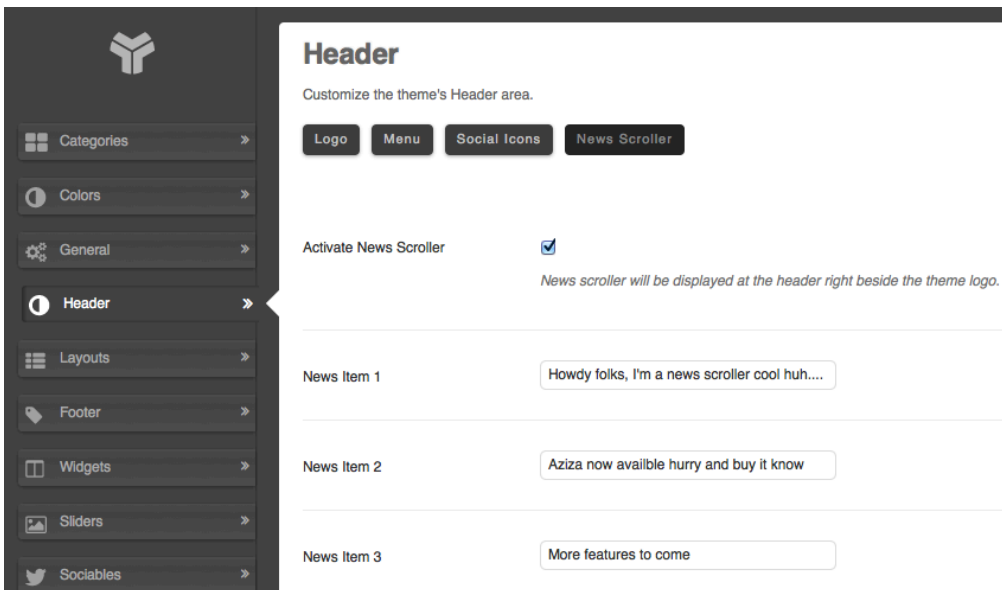





Social icons: select colors (already explained in chapter 05. Aziza Admin panel: colors)

Here you're able to set different layouts for separate pages, like: Default Page, Home Page, Search Page, Archive Page, 404 Page, Author Page, and Tag Page.

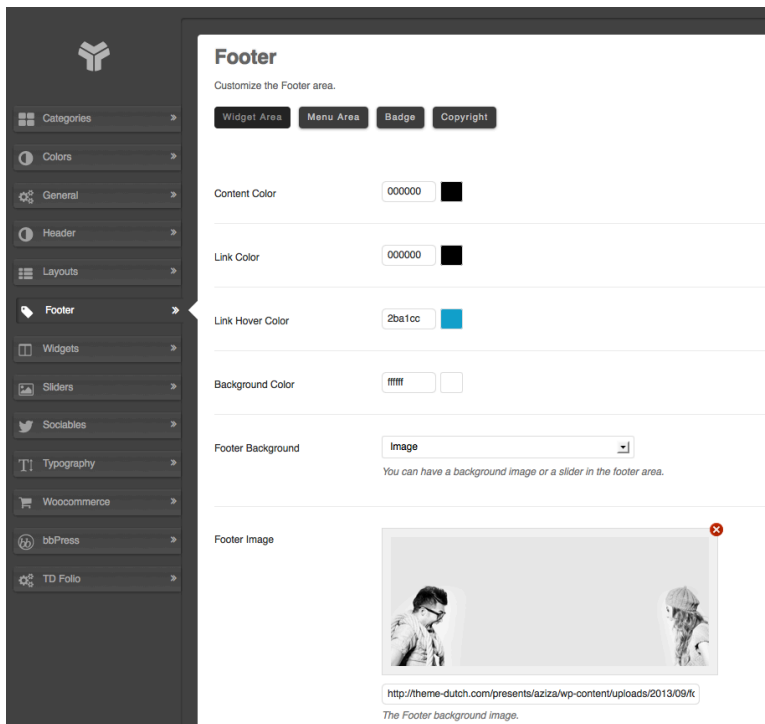

## 09. Aziza Admin panel - Footer

This option provides total freedom to customize your footer area the way you like it.

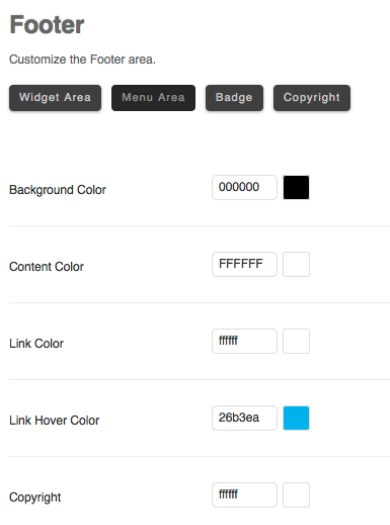
### Widget Area



Here you can select colors (already explained in chapter 05. Aziza Admin panel: colors). You're also able to select a background footer image, and upload it.

### Menu Area

Here you can select colors (already explained in chapter 05. Aziza Admin panel: colors).



## 10. Aziza Admin panel - Widgets / sidebars

This section allows you to add new sidebars, **(which can be filled with widgets via Appearance / Widgets)**, and remove the ones you don't need. **Sidebars** can be used to enhance the layout of your website's design. It can also be used to add more functionality to your site by **placing widgets**. These widgets can be a third-party AD (such as the ones offered by Google AdSense), search box, toolbars, plugins, HTML codes, analytics tools, etc.

To add / create a new sidebar:

1. Input the sidebar's name.

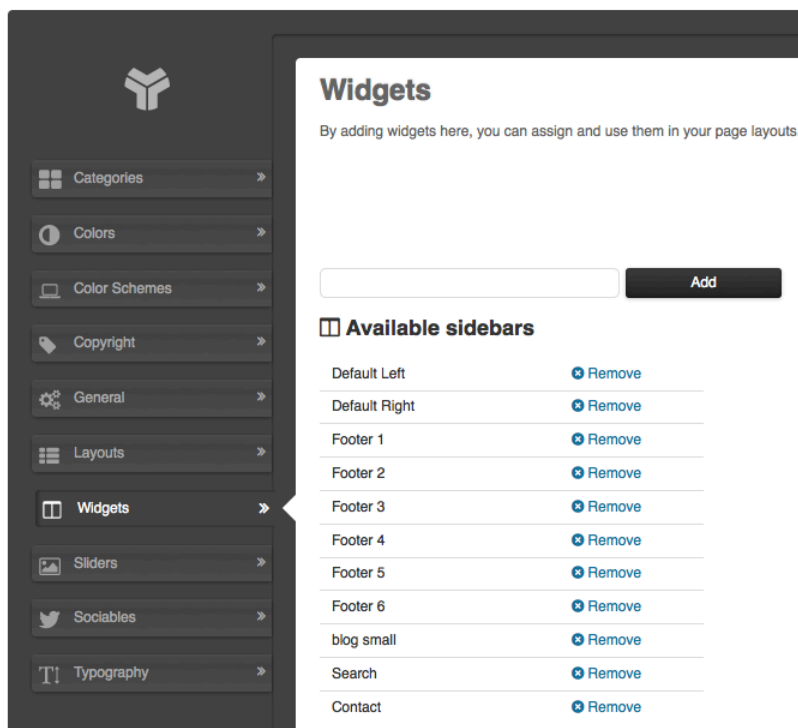

2. Hit the Add button.

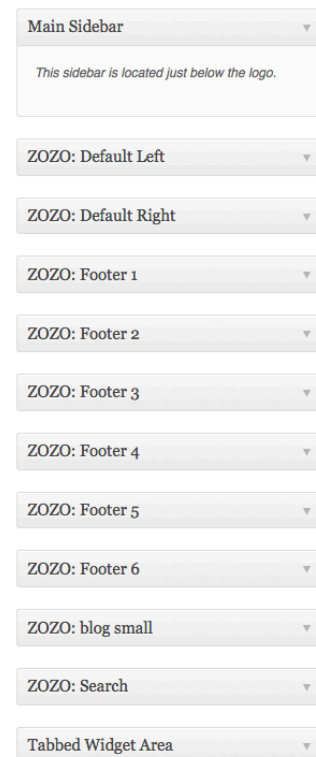
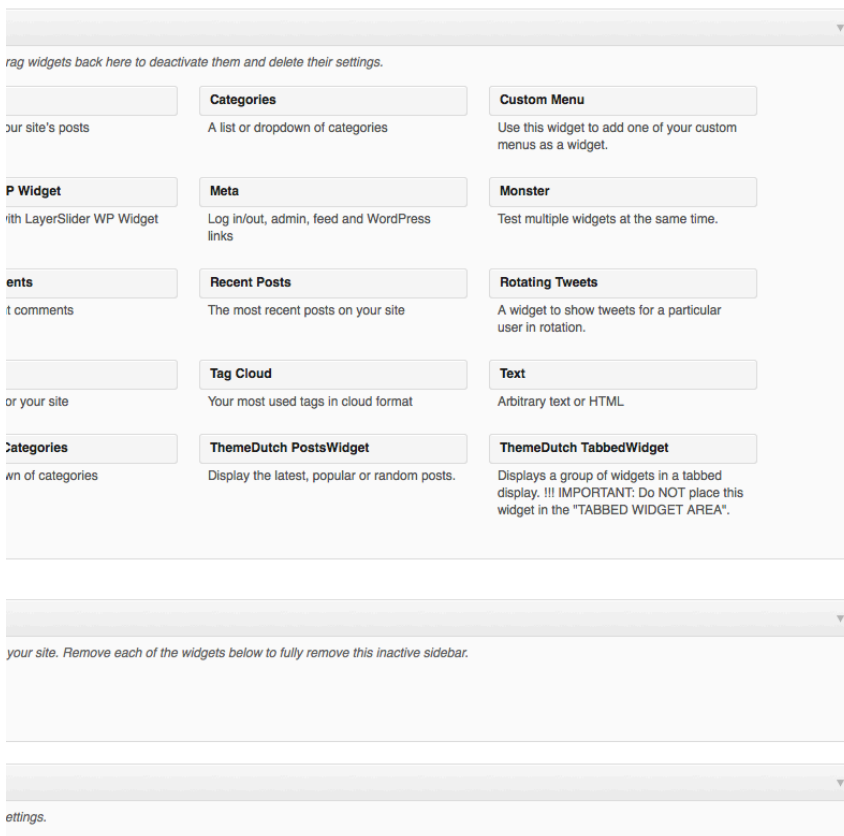
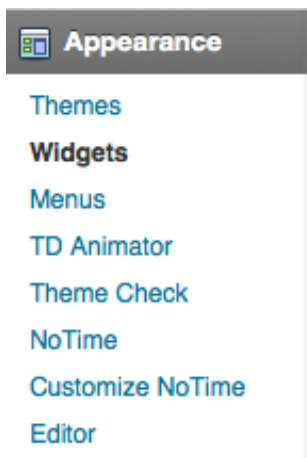
3. Click **Save changes**.

Your added sidebar is now incorporated to the theme..



**NOTE: Prevent using punctuations marks when creating a sidebar's title. Don't use characters like " , : \_ and so on in your sidebars titles. Using these characters in titles can cause issues that are not caused by the**

**theme, but conflicts with Msql and other used programs. You can access and set your sidebars at Appearance > Widgets.**



**Drag and drop the necessary widgets to the assigned sidebars at the right and fill them with texts or any other html content. (texts, images, video's).**

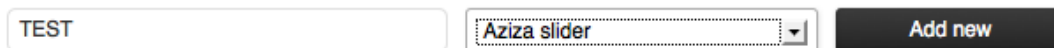
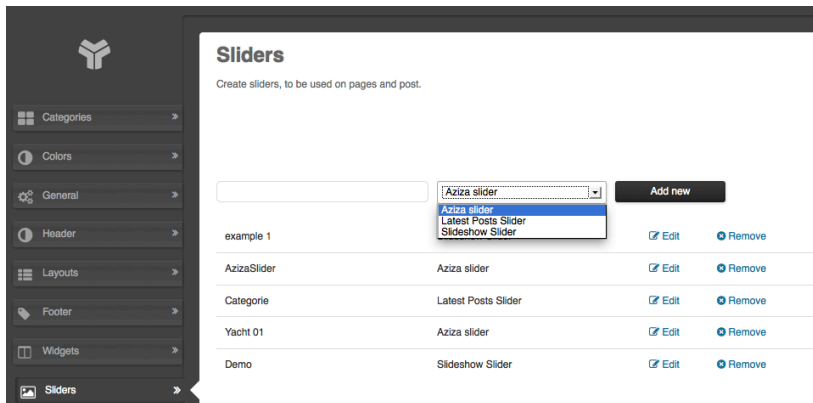

## 11. Aziza Admin panel - Sliders

Sliders can add visual appeal to your website. With content information and links they can also be used to enhance your visitors experience. Sliders can be added to pages or posts of your site, such as Home, Index page, Blog, About, Contact etc.

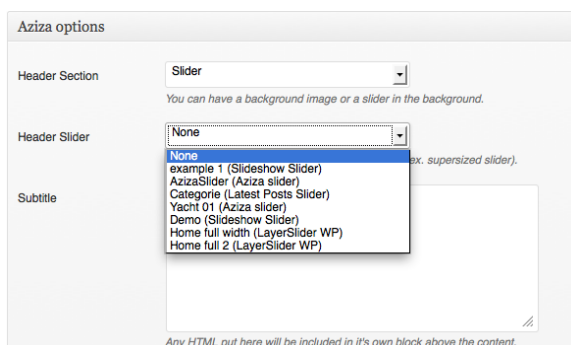


Here you're able to create different sliders, for different purposes, and which you can select on pages and posts. In the first box you'll have to type the name of your slider, and via the dropdown menu you'll have to select which available slider has to correspond. Then hit **Add New**, and Save Changes. Create as many sliders as you need.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** There are two options in theme AZIZA to create sliders.

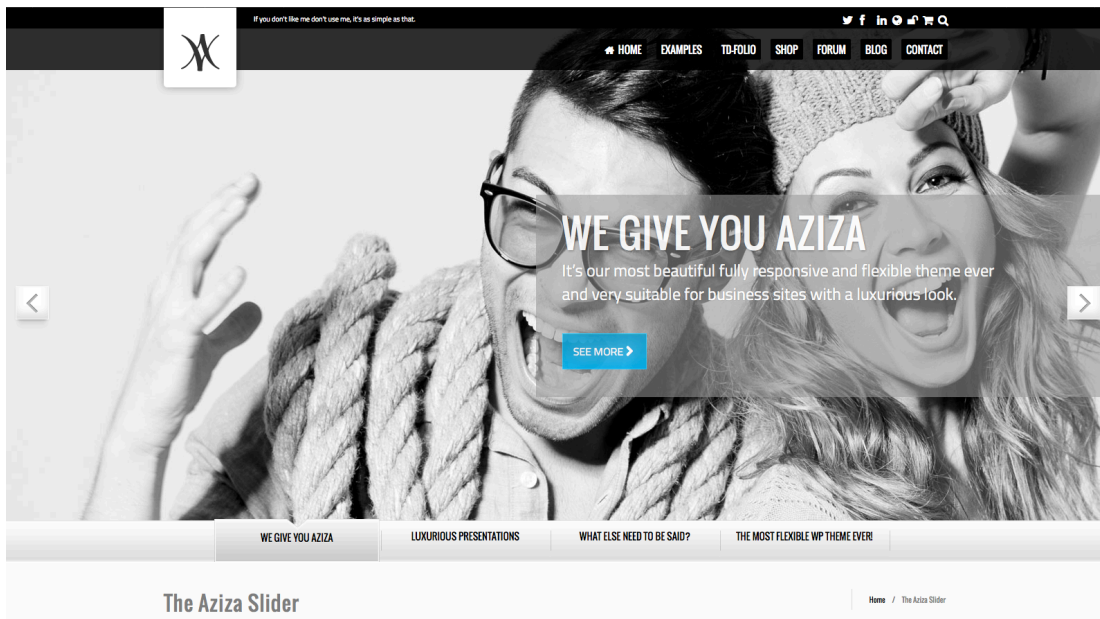
1. Via the Theme Dutch admin panel you're able to create: 1. Aziza Slider, 2. Category (Latest Post Slider), and 3, the Slideshow Slider.
2. The Layer Slider (after installation Plugin) can be created via the Wordpress admin panel

After you're done creating and designing sliders, you can activate them on your website's pages and posts via: Azia options. Read more about Aziza's pages and post options in chapter **16. Set up Page and Post options.**





## The Aziza Slider (via Aziza Admin panel – sliders)



This is the Aziza Slider as shown on our preview website.

Start editing the Aziza slider you've prepared already. Add a slide, and add an image, title, sub title, thumb text, button text, and link. (Just add what you need). Fill in the height, hit auto-play and pause on hover (if you want to), and fill out the slider's transition speed, color, and font sizes. Hit save! Add a new slide, fill the boxes with content, hit save, and your slider is ready before you know it. It's all up to you. Let your creativity work.

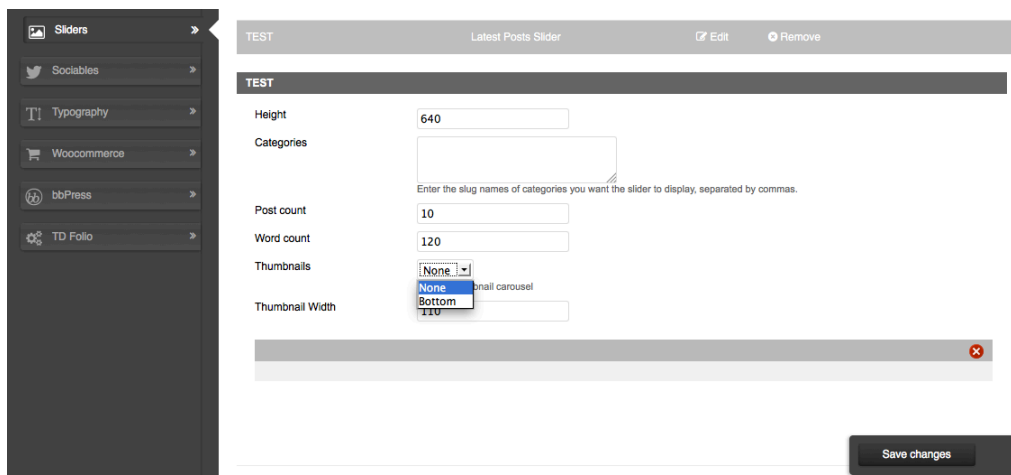
# The Aziza Category Slider (via Aziza Admin panel – sliders)

This is the Aziza Category Slider as shown on our preview website.



If you want your categories 'latest posts' thumbnails to be the content of your slider, then choose this option. You can use this slider type for content-rich categories, such as your Blog or Archives.

When editing **Latest Posts Slider**, you'll be presented with several options similar to the screenshot below. Start editing the Aziza Category slider you've prepared already.



**Height:** this is the slider's height, and measured in px.

**Categories:** you must specify here the slug names of the categories you want the slider to display. A slug is the part of a URL, which identifies a page using human-readable keywords, for example "this\_is\_my\_blog" or "cars". **Slugs** are used to construct clean URL's (often for perma links) that are easy to type, descriptive and easy to remember.

**Post count:** this is the number of latest posts the slider will have. 1 post is 1 slide. You can add as many slides as you want.

**Word count:** This is the amount of words you want to show from your post.

**Thumbnails:** Choose between Top and Bottom.

Thumbnail Width: this is the thumbnail's width, and measured in px.

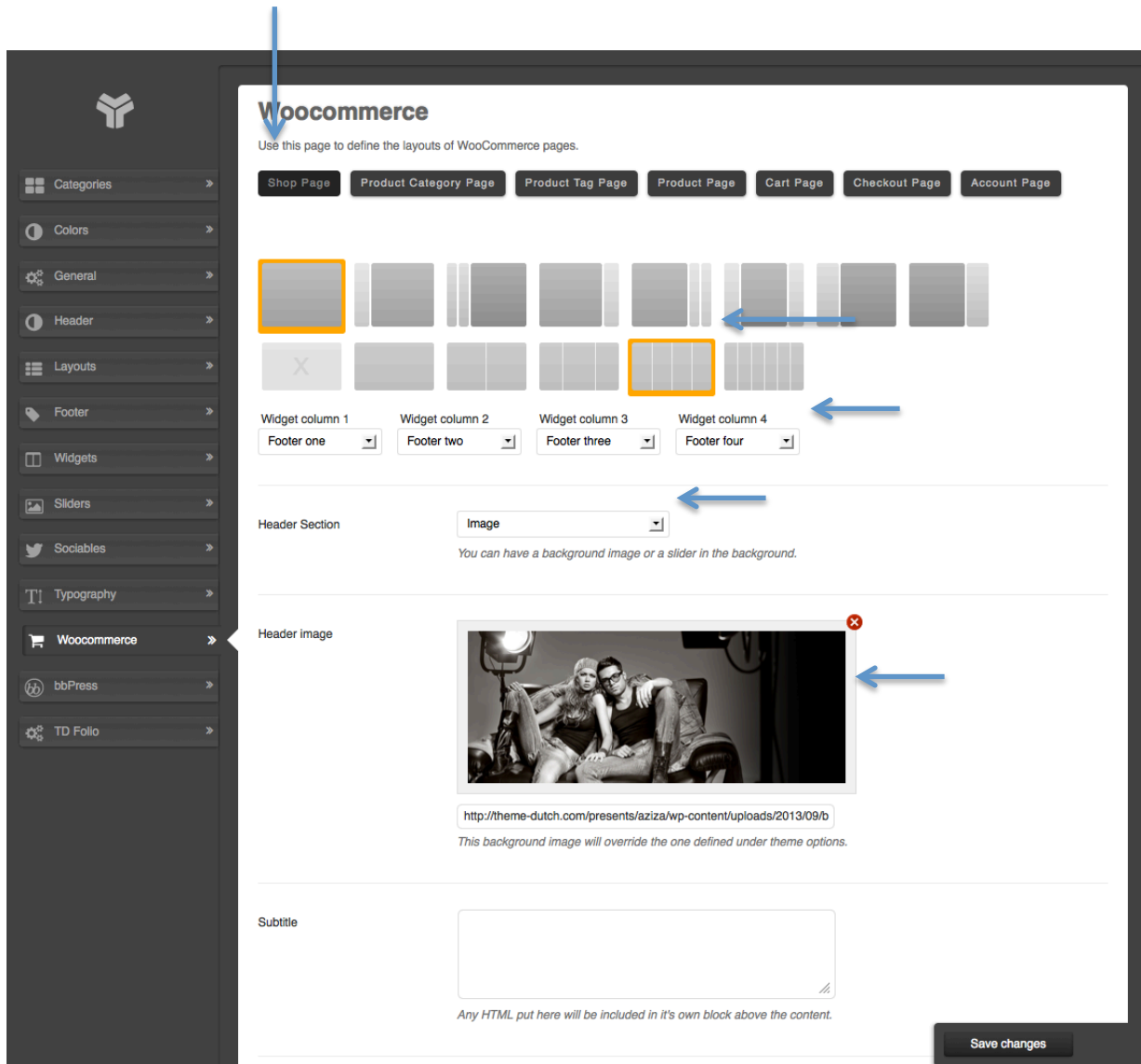


## 18. How to use Page and Post options

These options you'll find on your actual pages and posts, which you access via your Wordpress admin panel.

At the top of every page and post you'll find two tabs: **Add Media** and **Add Shortcodes**. Via Add Media you're able to insert your favorite images into your (post) pages. 

- 7) Poedit will ask you where to save the .po and .mo files. Choose the same folder. Call the files your language zone (example: nl-NL for the netherlands)
- 8) Translate all the options (not all needed)
- 9) Upload the .mo and .po file to the languages folder on your website.
- 10) Change you wp-config-file with your language-code
