CELM 100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the CELM 100 Club is to raise funds for the charity CELM. The money will be paid into the CELM bank account and used to maintain the Lismore Gaelic Heritage Centre and its activities.

RULES

1. For a cost of £5 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes are : 1st prize of £100, 2nd prize of £50 and 3rd prize of £25 for each month of the year.
4. The 100 Club is a small society lottery and is open to all. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
5. Payments must be made by standing order. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
6. Member's numbers will only be entered into the draw if their subscription is up to date.
7. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
8. The draw shall be made by a CELM board or committee member each month.
9. The prizes will be paid by BACS to the winners' bank accounts wherever possible, or by cheque or cash where not.
10. A record will be kept of each month's winners.
11. The 100 Club will be run by the CELM. In case of any dispute the decision of the Board is final.
12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
13. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into CELM funds.
14. If, on application, all tickets have been allocated, you will be informed and placed on a waiting list.
