All visitors having an instructed archery session receive a written statement on what to expect during their session and the rules of safe archery prior to starting.

Archers using their own equipment must register before using the archery butts

Outdoor archery - Walking in the firing area,	Injury to the public	4	1	4	The area is inspected before setting up to ensure there is 50 metre back drop inaccessible to the public. Use of low poundage bows to prevent the arrow travelling 50 metres	Low
