Fleet membership plans and how they work

Our unique points system allows us to build a plan that fits your boating needs. Plans are simply based on how often and which days of the week you'd like to be on the water, and the type of boats you'd like to use. If you plan to boat between 10 and 45 days over the year, then membership offers a truly flexible and affordable solution.

To build **the right membership plan for you**, we'll start by looking at the basics:

- What is your experience level and what types of boat do you enjoy?
- Which locations do you prefer?
- How often do you plan to be boating and will it be weekdays or mostly weekends?

From your **boating preferences** we build you a plan that gives you an allocation of points per year to spend on booking boats (or events, if you'd like). The points system makes booking easy and keeps our calendar flexible. Bigger boats use more points, as do weekend days and holidays. Boats are available year-round and most members use boats evenly across our three seasons (see overleaf), but if you'd prefer a different seasonal profile we can offer that too.

Our most popular membership plans

Most members enjoy about **25 days** boating over the year so the table below gives a price guide for this typical usage volume, on different boat types. Remember that whichever plan you take, you can use bigger (or smaller) boats which cost more (or less) points and correspondingly the number of days you enjoy will vary.

All plans provide access to our entire fleet.

New members pay a £300 joining fee.

All members must complete an induction and competency check before using any boat (charges apply).

How to save

- Pay annually in advance and save 5%
- Sign up for a 2 year contract and save a further 5%
- Join with a friend and share the cost for only £50 per month more

Seasons and Availability

Special memberships

Our fleet membership plans can accommodate most boaters, but we also offer the special membership plans below. If you have a requirement that is not covered then simply get in touch and we're confident we can work out a plan to suit you.

Single Boat membership is for locations where we have only one boat or if you simply want access to a single boat. Boat membership is different because you don't have the flexibility to use other boats. Instead, you enjoy a fixed number of days in each two-month booking period. Plans depend on the boat you choose and how many days you'd like to be on the water per two-month booking period.

- Freedom provides 7 days (5 weekday/2 weekend) every 2 months
- Peak provides 3 days (1 weekday/2 weekend) every 2 months
- Off-peak provides 4 weekdays every 2 months



Compare the alternatives

Pure Latitude membership boating takes the best features from various boating options and combines them into one. A genuinely innovative concept, and unlike any other in the market. Compare with the traditional alternatives:

Owning a high-quality 35ft boat typically means an initial purchase of £100-200k and perhaps an additional £10-20k per year to run. For all that, you're locked into one boat at one marina - and don't forget the cost of capital and depreciation!

Syndicates are essentially shared ownership so still only one boat, and more importantly it's difficult to enter and exit because the market for shares is small. With different personalities managing the boat, duties like maintenance and cleaning can be a source of discomfort and disputes.

Chartering a boat each time you want to go out is time-consuming and too often unreliable. Did you negotiate the best deal? Are the boats kept in tiptop shape? How long should you spend checking the boat over? Perhaps most importantly, you don't get the confidence and pleasure of taking your favourite and familiar boats.

As a new sailor, buying a boat raised too many questions. Which boat should I buy? Where would I keep it? Who would I go sailing with? Membership boating answered a lot of these, but what model and company would suit me best? I looked into them all, made up my mind, and then changed it when I met Pure Latitude. If there's a smart decision in sailing, this is it.

FAQs-contract and cost

Can I join in the middle of the sailing season? You can join at any time and all contracts run from the first day of the agreed month.

Can I buy extra points if I use up all of mine? Yes, subject to available capacity, you can buy more points. However, the more points you buy at the start of your membership the better the volume discount will be.

Can I share my membership with a friend? Yes, our joint membership option is popular. For only £50 more per month, you and your friend can each reserve boats separately. If you cruise together though, only one of you needs to join and no additional fee is due.

After membership, joining and induction fees, are there any other charges? We take care of all the running costs — insurance, mooring, maintenance, etc. You'll only pay for the fuel you use on motorboats and of course for training and events.

How do inductions work? A full induction covers operating procedures, location information, boat systems, handling characteristics and a check on competency. Further inductions for additional boats typically take 2-3 hours depending on experience and are charged by the hour.

Can I pay for events in points? Yes, Pure Latitude events can be paid for in points. We split the cost of our event charges across your 3 seasons allocation of points. This mean you are using mid and low season points even when you are out on the water in August.

Can I pay for training in points? Yes and no. Boats are paid for in points but instructors must be paid for in pounds.

How do fuel charges work? For motorboats only, we charge for fuel at cost plus an hourly service charge (to contribute to servicing and wear and tear), all based on installed flow meters. For yachts, we pay all fuel costs, based upon "fair use". We require a £100 deposit from all motorboat users to be held on account against future fuel invoices. Fuel invoices are sent monthly on the 1st of the month.

How does the deposit work? We reserve the right to take a refundable damage deposit up to £1500 (£2500 for Squadron 42). If any damage or loss occurs to a Pure Latitude or third-party boat, the cost of repair (limited to £1500/£2500 for each incident) will be charged to the member.

Am I insured? Yes, all members are insured under Pure Latitude's insurance policy. In the event of damage, the member will be liable for costs incurred up to the maximum liability of £1500 (£2500 for Squadron 42).

What is the length of the contract commitment? A minimum of 12 months.





FAQs-Using and Booking Boats

How do I book boats? Book a boat anytime online!

How far in advance do I have to book? Booking is flexible and operates on a two-month rolling window, so the available calendar will always be between 2-4 months in advance. You can book right up to the last minute, plus make limited long-range bookings to secure a special date or holiday.

Can I bring friends and family on board with me? Please do! The boat is yours to invite guests and crew as you choose. Similarly, you are welcome to bring guests to any of our Pure Latitude events. You can also use our crew match service to arrange crew or crewing opportunities with other members.

Where do I pick up and drop off the keys each time I sail? Keys are held conveniently at marina offices, enabling 24-hour access to the boat.

Can I stay overnight on board? Yes, that is part of the fun. All bookings run from 7pm the day before your booking until 7pm on the day of your booking. In the summer this means you can enjoy an early evening trip prior to your full day—essentially 2 days for the price of 1. All boats except small powerboats have diesel heaters, so winter nights on board are cosy.

How far can I take the boat? Bookings are limited to eight days, so as far as you can get in that time! Just consider your combined experience and the boat model, plus the usual factors of time, tide, distance and weather. If you're going beyond 20 miles from base, we'd like you to tell us in advance.

What safety standards do you operate to? It goes without saying that safety is paramount in boating. All our boats are MCA coded, which means they carry all required safety gear, including life jackets, flares and rafts. We inspect our boats regularly and follow a strict maintenance programme.

How is the boat equipped? Because the boats are coded to MCA category 2, the UK's industry standard, they have a full inventory of cruising equipment (details on request). You simply need to bring your own boating clothing and, if overnighting, sleeping bags and of course food.

Who is responsible for cleaning the boat? The boats are professionally cleaned monthly, but Pure Latitude membership requires a degree of trust and co-operation. The simple rule is "leave it as you'd like to find it" - in other words, clean. We ask members to wash down the boat after use, wipe and sweep internal surfaces and remove their rubbish.

Will you be changing the boats at all? Yes, Pure Latitude reviews the fleet continuously—we added two new boats in 2015. We're constantly growing and adding boats to our fleet and members are invited to comment on replacements and upgrades.
