

Dear SU,

The below information is based on the most recent government update and was correct on 23/03/2020.

The current government advice is that if employees are sick with Covid-19 or are self-isolating in line with government advice then they are entitled to statutory sick pay (if they qualify) from day 1 rather than after 3 waiting days.

In order to qualify for SSP employees must earn at least £118 per week. In normal situations when a PA doesn't qualify for SSP we provide them with an SSP1 form, and they claim directly themselves. It seems that currently they may be able to apply for <u>Universal Credit</u> or <u>Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)</u>.

If you ask your PA not to attend work, the employer is advised to pay their wages in full as the PA has made themselves available for work.
