Top this week 228.5pkg for a very smart heifer from G D Black & Son and purchased by Tony Cracknell, Ipswich. Tony Evans Limousin steers to 217.5pkg (2), British Blue steer to 217.5pkg and Limousin heifer to 208.5pkg. G D Black & Son Limousin steers to 214.5, 211.5pkg etc. Ben Whiting BBX heifers to 217.5pkg (2), S G Grover Continental heifer to 204.5pkg. O+ butcher types 180 to 191pkg with O- 123 to 162.5pkg. Bulls a good show selling well on current levels. Considering the reported substantial drops in the deadweight trade, then trade satisfactory but still not at levels required. Top prices per head £1,338.65 for steer from G D Black & Son, heifer to £1,247.78 from Martin Farms.
