To raise awareness of staff who may have to administer C.P.R, use Defibrillators or EPI pens with regards to heart- attacks, cardiac- arrests and anaphylactic shock

Programme Objectives

By the end of the session candidates will be able to:

- State what emergency action may be required for a given situation.
- Demonstrate Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation with adults and/or children.
- Demonstrate Automated External Defibrillation with adults and/or children.
- Be familiar with safety aspects regarding CPR and DEFIB.
- Identify the different heart conditions and the ways in which they will be present.
- List some of the typical signs and symptoms regarding heart problems.
- Recognise signs and symptoms of anaphylaxis and how to treat it.
- Understand priorities when dealing with anaphylactic shock and cardiac arrest.
- Be competent in the use of EPI pens.
- State when emergency services should be called.
- Understand the importance of time when dealing with emergency situations.
