The mixture should be a soft dropping consistency, if too dry Add a little hot water. Spoon into a 7" round cake tin and spread level. Bake for 1 1/2 - 2 hours. Leave cake in the tin to cool for 10 mins before Turning out. Store in airtight tin and leave for a week to improve the Flavour.


