Health and Safety Policy Statement.

The Company requires and expects all employees, sub-contractors and others engaged by us on our sites to take personal responsibility for their compliance with the Company’s health and safety policies, procedures and practises relating to the work activities being undertaken.

The Company shall take all reasonable practicable steps to meet or exceed its responsibilities under the Health and Safety at Work, etc Act 1974 and associated legislation, Regulations, Approved Codes of Practise, Guidance Notes and other industry best practises. The Company’s commitment to this Health and Safety policy Statement and the provision and maintenance of safe working environments is supported by a corresponding pledge to provide the necessary resources to achieve these aims.

This Policy Statement is reviewed annually to reflect the company’s continual awareness for, the improvement in and the promotion of the highest standards of occupational health, safety and welfare standards within all Departments and levels of the company.
