The current Sandpiper is almost entirely 2014 wines, and a fresh vibrant wine it is, sure to please. Old freinds like Sex and Blanc de Noirs keep us happy this winter.

And the new kid, Domaine Leelanau Omena, is available for you Bubbleheads. We've produced 1185 bottles of this traditional method sparkler. Almost entirely from the 2011 vintage [with just a touch of 2010 reserve wine], 75% pinot noir, 25% chardonnay from vines grown on the hills west of Omena.

Barrel fermented juice, refermented in the bottle and aged en tirage before disgorging with a Brut dosage [0.8% RS]. This is a not to be repeated wine [oh, we'll do Omena again, but it will not be the same].
