

ECG Academy Advisory Group ELECTION NOTICE 2020

We would like to announce that the elections for the ECG Academy Advisory Group (EAAG) are now open. The EAAG elections take place every two years. The new EAAG will officially start its activities from 7 February 2020 at the 7th Alumni meeting when it will take over from the current group.

What is EAAG?

The EAAG was established in October 2010 as a means of harnessing the enthusiasm and growing experience in this exclusive club for the benefit of the sector. The EAAG is composed of up to 9 Alumni and 1 Executive Secretary (ECG).

What does the EAAG do?

- ECG Academy Alumni Meeting

An annual meeting is organised by the EAAG in co-operation with ECG. The scope of the meeting is to gather together as many as possible of the 250+ Alumni of the Academy. The Alumni meeting is a mini-conference with a well-established format consisting of a networking dinner and a meeting where speakers from the industry are invited to present on topics of interest. The meeting is also attended by the ECG Board.

- Cooperation with the ECG Board Currently two members of the EAAG attend ECG Board meetings as guests to support their activities and co-operate on common projects.
- Projects

The EAAG worked on different projects in the past on topics linked to the FVL industry. New projects on which the EAAG will work on will be established in co-operation with the ECG Board.

Please note that if you wish to become part of EAAG <u>a certain amount of commitment in terms of time</u> <u>is required</u>. The EAAG holds at least one physical meeting and up to 5 conference calls per year.

In case of late cancellation, after **31/01/2020**, or failure to register in person on Friday morning ECG will invoice you €150 to recover the costs incurred on your behalf. **Please note that attending the dinner on Thursday evening does not constitute attendance at the conference.**
