It will run from 11.00am to 2.30pm and will include presentations from Swindon Carers Centre; Sue Wald from Swindon Borough Council (SBC); Robin Butcher from the Swindon Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and Newlands Anning from the Avon and Wiltshire Mental Health Partnership NHS Trust (AWP). There will also be two workshops discussing how to improve the awareness of services for carers and pressure on services caused by the impact of an aging population.
