Detailed instructions are on the document itself. The document will be collected sometime during the first cycle of the school year.

You are expected to read the books and prepare carefully for your summer reading assessments which will take place over the course of September.

- 1. You will complete an individual assignment based on one or both of the books you have read.
- 2. You will take part in a group project exploring one of the books you have read.
