Jessie May is a charity that provides specialist nursing care for terminally ill children in their own homes.

We offer vital respite care and emotional support to children's families, as well as end of life care and bereavement support, allowing families to make the most of the precious time they have together and creating treasured family memories.

Since 1996 Jessie May Nurses have provided hospice at home care to terminally ill children in Bristol, Bath and North East Somerset, South Gloucestershire, North Somerset and most recently, Swindon and Wiltshire. Jessie May also takes children out into the community, hosts respite days, and provides support to children who are admitted to hospital. In 2015 we launched our first official schools project called 'Get Messy for Jessie'. The project was thought up by one of our nurse's children – one day he asked, "Why don't people get Messy for Jessie? It would be really cool." We agreed, and Get Messy for Jessie was born.

You can take part in Get Messy for Jessie however you like. That could mean a messy hair day, having a day painting, gardening, crafting or cooking, or sponsoring a brave person to sit in a bathtub of baked beans! Think mud, gunge or paint... get creative and say YES to the MESS!
