The classic Herringbone design can

be traced back to the Romans who used the design in the construction of roads to add strength. The pattern became know as "Herring - Bone" as it resembles the out line of a fish skeleton. The Renaissance periods

between the 14th and 17th centuries saw the design being used in many

aspects of architectural design

including flooring. Traditional real wood Herringbone has long been a desirable choice to add a touch

of class to any room or entrance hallway. Laminate manufacturing

Herringbone Installation: Floating Valinge Click System

Note: Floors must be perfectly level before installing laminate Herringbone. Any variation in floor levels must be corrected prior to installation. Herringbone is supplied in equal quantities of packs of left and right pieces - packs "A" and "B".
