Kitchen Duties

- Preparation of basic food.
- Unloading deliveries from suppliers.
- Washing kitchen appliances, work surfaces, floors and walls.
- Wash up dirty crockery, cutlery and kitchen equipment.
- Prepare food trolleys ready for the meal to be served.
- From time to time you may be required to assist in catering for special events.

- Follow ecological waste disposal of food packaging and food waste.
- Assist the Head Cook and Cook to carry out weekly/monthly cleaning tasks to ensure high standard of cleanliness in the kitchen and larders.

- Follow ecological and environmentally sustainable practices.
