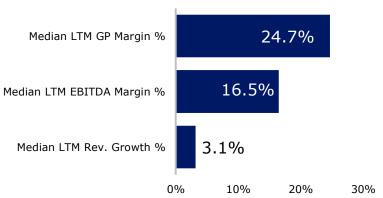

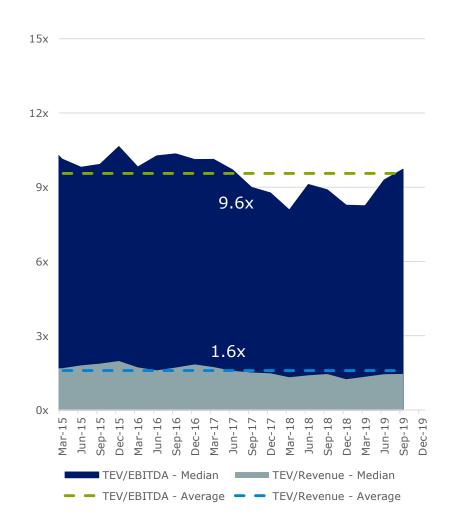

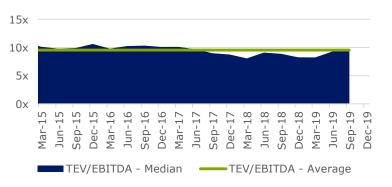

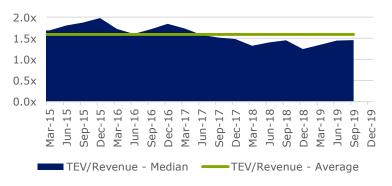




Public EBITDA Multiples over Time



<u>Public Revenue Multiples over Time</u>

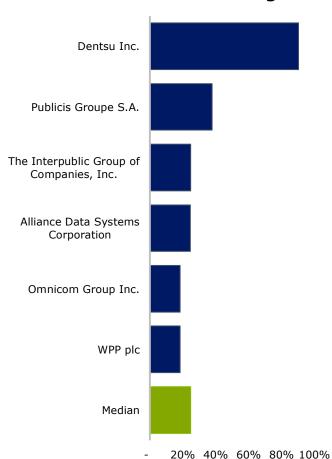




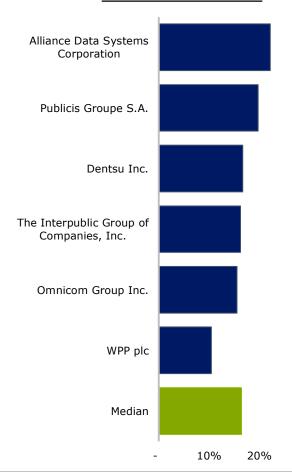

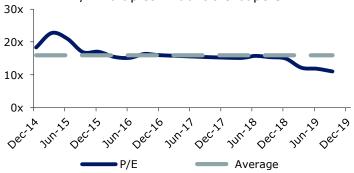




EBITDA Multiples - Publicis Groupe S.A.
