Can you take some pictures and give examples e.g. iPad, laptop, tablet, Xbox, Nintendo, phone etc.?</p> <p>Can I draw a picture of where different animals live in a farm, for example a pig lives in a sty?</p> <p>Can I plant some seeds and grow a plant?</p> <p>Can I explore a range of phonic websites?</p>
