## GB Athlete numbers for the 2017 London World Championships and their medal chances

<u>Previous Fact Files</u>. From time to time ABAC has looked at the numbers of GB athletes performing at Olympic and World Championships The last one analysed the 2013 World Championships in Moscow and recorded that in 2013 UKA sent one of the smallest teams comprising 29 men and 30 women.

**2017 World Championships London.** Normally GB athletic teams for the Olympics are larger than those sent to World Championships. It is to be applauded that as the 2017 meeting is in London a larger than normal team should be entered and a number of late additions has resulted in record team size. For comparison:-

Olympics. 2012. GB team comprised 44 men and 33 women. Total 77. 2016. GB team comprised 35 men and 33 women. Total 68. Worlds. 2013. GB team comprised 29 men and 30 women. Total 59 2017. GB team comprises 45 men and 47 women. Total 92

<u>What chances of medals?</u> Previous Fact Files have recorded that more than 80% of medals at track and field Championships have gone to top 10 ranked athletes.

The table below, compiled from the **topsinathletics** website lists for each event, the 2017 performance of the top 10 ranked athlete in the world and lists the British Athletes ranked in the World's top 10. It is noted that some ranked athletes will not be at the championships. The GB athletes rankings in the World Top 10 are as of August 1<sup>st</sup> 2017.

**Comments.** With only three men and seven women ranked in the World's top 10 as we enter the London World Track and Field Championships it would appear that the UK Sport medal target of 6 will be hard to achieve. From time to time the GB relay squads have contributed to the medal count but this year we see little chance of that happening.
