

ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE MOVE



- Pick a date for the move. Inform your moving company and confirm it.
- Make a list of all the items you are taking.

THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO THE MOVE



- Clear the garage and make sure you are taking everything you need.
- If you have pets, make sure you have proper transport for them or at least someone to take care of them during the move.

TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE MOVE



- Mark things that you'll be taking yourself and those you don't want moved.
- Make sure food packets and jars are properly sealed before the move.
- If you store fabric, protect them from moth infestations.



- Drain all the fuel of lawn mowers or motorcycles.
- Make sure that fittings and fixtures you are taking along are removed.
- Make sure all greenhouses, sheds, or any garden structures you have are dismantled or taken care of by professionals.

ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE MOVE



- Sort out and prepare all your plants for the move.
- If needed, confirm that you can rely on somebody to look after your children on the day of the move.
- Check all your drawers and cabinets for items you might have missed while packing. If you are taking chest of drawers, they can be left full depending on their contents and type.



- If you are moving in or out of a block of flats, make sure you have priority use of the key for the lift on moving day.
- All satellite dishes or aerials should be taken down if you are taking any along.
- Make sure all light fittings are disconnected.
- Arrange for somebody to read all the meters for electricity, gas, water and telephone.



- Disassemble all the heavy pieces of furniture you are taking with you or ask the removal company to do it for you.
- Make sure the loft is cleared or arrange a service to take care of it.



- Start emptying the freezers. We do not recommend moving full freezers.
- Double check if you will need professional help to disconnect all of your appliances (gas cookers, washing machine, etc.) and arrange it.

ONE DAY PRIOR TO THE MOVE



- Take all your valuables with you, do not leave them in the boxes!
- Remember to keep all important possessions and documents (such as passport, driving licence, etc.) on you.



- If you will use storage, do not store any valuables or important documents.
- Make sure you are not storing any flammable items.



- After everything has been loaded, do a final check-up and make sure nothing is forgotten.



- Make sure our crew knows the exact address of your home and has directions if needed.
- Confirm time for the arrival and make sure they have your phone number to contact you.
