## **Meeting Notes:**

#### Aims of the Meeting

• To agree the B+NP Specification and Project Plan (forwarded to attendees 30<sup>th</sup> April 2018) (an updated Project Plan was circulated at the meeting and is attached to this meeting note),

• To agree the mechanism and timing by which unpublished LPR evidence will be shared with the B+NP group.

# Blandford + Neighbourhood Plan Specification (30<sup>th</sup> April 2018)

Background (pages 1. & 2.) Agreed subject to notes below

# **Landscape Analysis**

Ed confirmed the Landscape Analysis has not been updated since the work carried out by Tony Harris (DCC) in 2010. Leani informed the group that there is potentially an option for DCC to provide a proportionate / fast update.

### **SEA / Screening**

It was put forward by B+ that a screening opinion for the SEA would not be required, as it is known that the NP will be allocating sites, and therefore will be preparing a SA/SEA. However, NDDC consider that there is no harm in carrying out a screening opinion and would therefore start this process straight away. This screening work will take approximately 4-5 weeks but will not affect the B+NP2 timetable. NDDC will inform B+ if any further information is required. It was agreed that the 'Proposed B+NP2 Policy Scope' on pages 6&7 of the B+ NP Specification (30<sup>th</sup> April 2018) and the NDDC 'Michelin Man' would be used as the basis for the screening. A screening request has therefore been prepared and will be submitted to NDDC with the circulation of these notes.

#### **HRA / Screening**

The SA/SEA and a Habitats Regulations Assessment has been commissioned through Locality Technical Support and work on the SA/SEA Scoping Report has commenced by AECOM. A formal HRA screening will be requested from NDDC with the circulation of these notes.

## **Sharing Evidence**

**ACTION:** Ed to clarify with NDDC legal team whether all evidence / documents can be shared with B+ (for planning purposes) without being redacted, and prior to publication. This will prevent delays while waiting to upload onto the website.

(AFTER MEETING NOTE: Ed has checked and has been informed that all documents must be redacted of personal information before being shared.)

## **Issues & Options Consultation Reps**

**ACTION:** Ed to investigate timescales for publishing the Issues & Options Consultation Reps, and if necessary send them to B+ directly. Agreed deadline 15<sup>th</sup> May.

## **Blandford Housing and Infrastructure Requirements**

NDDC reserved comment on the first two assumptions set out on page 3 of the specification and wish consider this further i.e.

- The requirement to allocate land for at least 400 homes (upper OAN3 with the same District spatial strategy)
- 2 Ha employment land (to assist in making up the shortfall in existing employment land supply identified in the Workplace Strategy)

**ACTION: Ed** to provide comment and feedback by 15<sup>th</sup> May

The last three assumptions were agreed i.e.

- 2FE primary school (based on DCC Pupil Places Statement 2017 with flexibility for expansion for any additional requirement identified by DCC in their updated evidence)
- Delivery of the necessary highway and green infrastructure
- 'Areas of Search' to be those identified in the Local Plan Review Issues and Options consultation as possibly having some development potential. These areas are A, B, E, F & J as defined by the map in Appendix A. Any available previously developed land within the settlement boundary will also be considered drawing on the evidence provided by the NDDC SHELAA and Brownfield Register

#### SHELAA 2017 - Call for Sites

**ACTION: Ed** to share submissions by 15<sup>th</sup> May.

Appraisals of the submissions are not complete, so it was agreed to set up a smaller meeting between NDDC and B+ after B+ have had chance to review the submissions. This will enable NDDC / B+ to share their thinking / opinions.

**ACTION: Sally** to arrange. Attendees: Ed Gerry, Jon Dowty, Leani, Sally. The meeting will be evidence based so Dave Chetwyn's attendance will not be required.

# **DCC Draft Waste Plan**

It was agreed that a 'Statement of Common Ground' should be prepared between the Waste Authority (DCC), NDDC and B+ for submission to the Waste Plan examination.

**ACTION:** OH to arrange for the preparation of an initial draft and provide an update on this matter to B+ and NDDC/DCC (Richard Dodson) when available

# **DCC Pupil Placement Strategy**

Currently being updated by DCC.

Action: B+ to liaise with DCC to obtain an updated statement based on indicative housing growth and updated pupil forecasts.

#### **DCCG Clinical Services Review**

B+NP2 will require an update on the recommendations of the DCCG Clinical Services Review relating to future options for the Whitecliff Practice and Blandford Clinic.

ACTION: B+ to liaise with the DCCG for this information to be made available as soon as possible
