SUBJECT: Ordered Departure – Mongolia

The Department of State (DOS) has approved an Ordered Departure from Embassy Ulaanbaatar, which includes all of Mongolia, for eligible family members (EFMs) under the age of 21, including DoD EFMs, effective March 10, 2020.

DOS had previously approved an Authorized Departure from Embassy Ulaanbaatar, which includes all of Mongolia, for all EFMs, including DoD EFMs, and non-emergency civilian personnel, effective February 25, 2020.

The Authorized Departure remains in effect, except that DoD EFMs under the age of 21 are now ordered to depart Mongolia. The designated safe-haven for departing DoD EFMs is the United States. The designated safe-haven for departing DoD non-emergency civilian personnel is Arlington, Virginia.

The Stop Forward Movement order suspending U.S. Government-funded travel to Mongolia for all DoD EFMs and non-emergency civilian personnel remains in effect.

The Authorized and Ordered Departures will remain in effect until terminated by DOS, and the Stop Forward Movement Order will remain in effect until terminated by me.

DoD EFMs of Service members will be processed for safe-haven allowances in accordance with the Joint Travel Regulations (JTR), Chapter 6 (Evacuation Travel), paragraph 0602. DoD civilian employees and their EFMs will be processed for allowances in accordance with the JTR, Chapter 6, paragraph 0604.
