

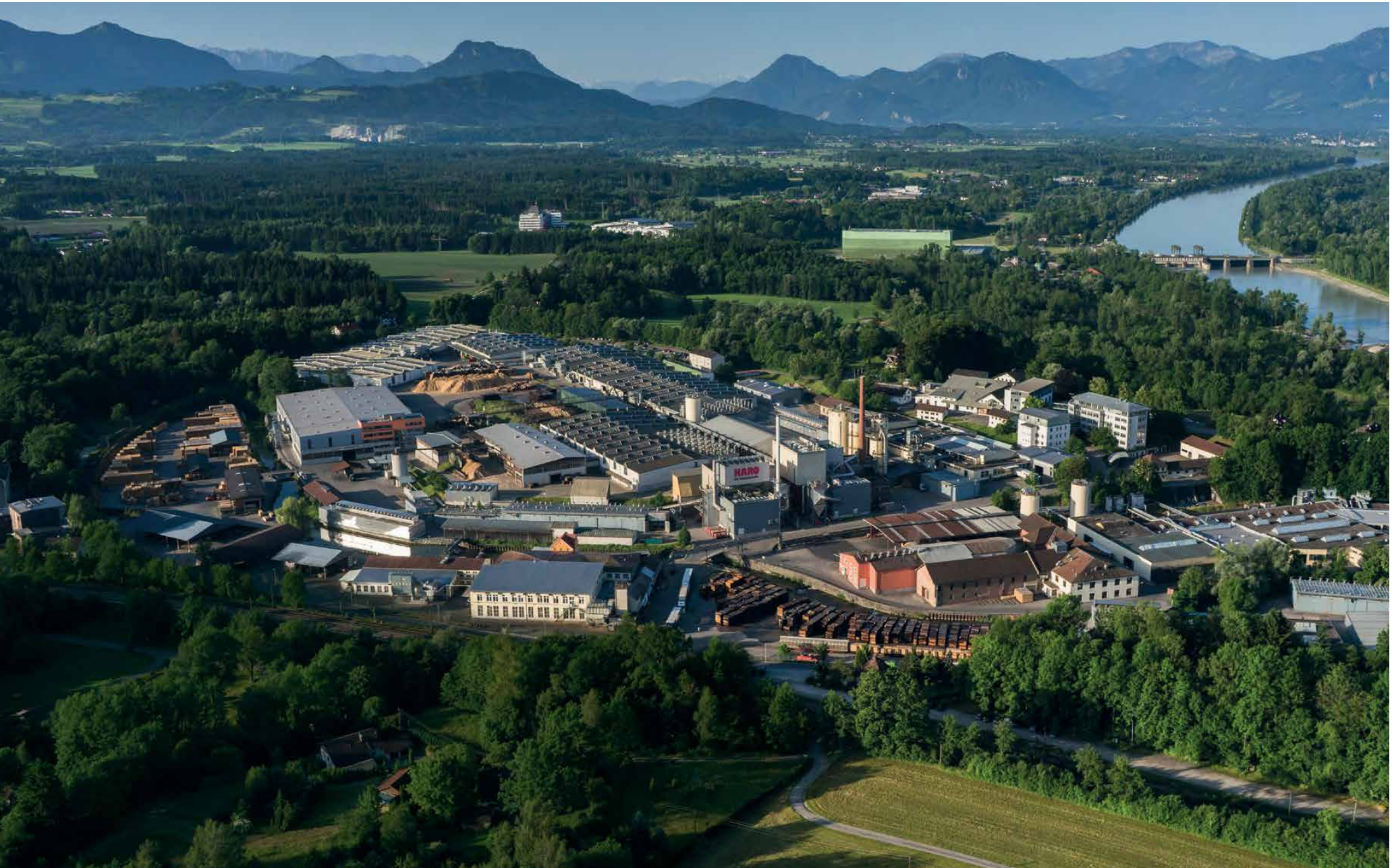



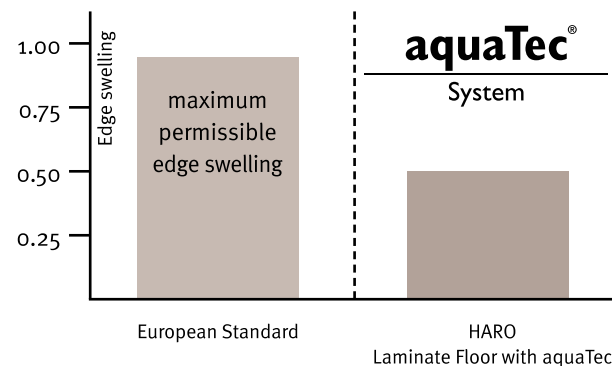
One of the signs of the quality of our laminate floors is the high UV resistance. Due to their special impregnation the colours remain stable when exposed to sunlight and do not lose their brightness. Another advantage of the impregnation is the resistance to stains and scratches. The high durability of the top layer also prevents the surface from long-term damage from abrasion (for example by shifting chairs) or heat effects (for example by cigarette burns). In general, the HARO quality guidelines are specified so they exceed standards by far.

LAMINATE

Dry Cleaning: It is usually sufficient to clean your HARO Laminate Floor dry using a dust mop, soft broom or vacuum cleaner.

Damp cleaning: We recommend that the floors be mopped regularly with clean & green active depending on how dirty the floor is and wear and tear. Add half a dosage cap of clean & green active to five litres of water. Then wipe the surface with a well-wrung, slightly damp cloth. Don't clean the floor surface too damp, always avoid letting water stand on the surface. By polishing the floor with a cloth afterwards you can optimize the shine of your floor's surface.

Intensive care: To optically refresh the floor and improve durability, we recommend that you use clean & green aqua shield. Start by thoroughly cleaning the floor (dust-free). We recommend clean & green active for this job. clean & green aqua shield is applied undiluted with a flat microfibre mop. Evenly apply the clean & green aqua shield in overlapping lines with the mop. The room temperature should be between 18° and 22°C with relative humidity of 45% to 65%. Coverage: about 30 ml/m² (depends on the absorbing power of the surface) Wait about 2 hours before subjecting the floor to traffic and load. The application of clean & green aqua shield can lead to changes in the gloss level.

DISANO CLASSIC AQUA

Dry cleaning/marks: It is generally sufficient to clean DISANO dry using a mop, soft broom or vacuum cleaner. Any rubber marks from shoe soles or grease marks can be removed with ethanol. Spilt oil should be removed immediately from the floor because of the higher risk of slipping. The longer period effect of aggressive solvents, such as acetone or disinfectants, can cause surface changes. Such substances must be removed immediately from the DISANO surface.

Initial cleaning/damp mopping: We recommend initial cleaning and damp mopping your floor surface regularly with clean & green natural diluted in water. Cleaning frequency depends here on the wear and tear your floor is subjected to.

Intensive cleaning: To remove major soiling and ingrained dirt, you can use clean & green active for intensive cleaning. Treat the floor with clean & green natural after each basic cleaning.

Please note: Do not use soap-based detergents, abrasive cleaners, scouring powder, aggressive solutions, steel wool, wax or polish for cleaning and maintenance. Always avoid letting water stand on the DISANO by HARO surface. Steam cleaning machines are not suitable for cleaning the floor.



For regular dry cleaning of the HARO floor coverings, we recommend using a vacuum cleaner. For regular damp cleaning of the HARO floor coverings, we recommend flat microfibre mops.

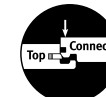

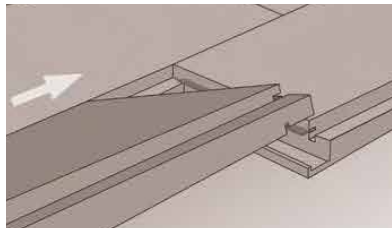

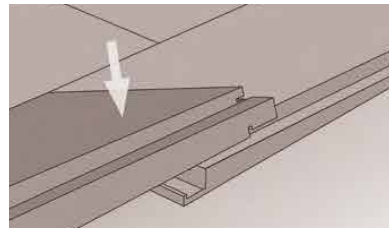

TOP CONNECT

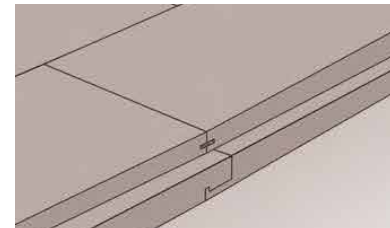

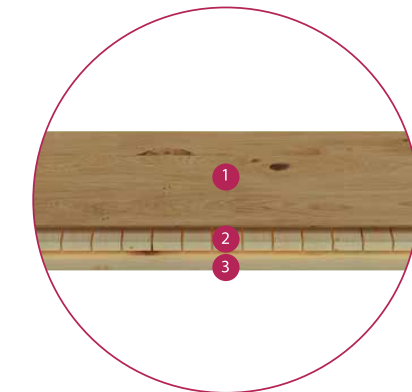
