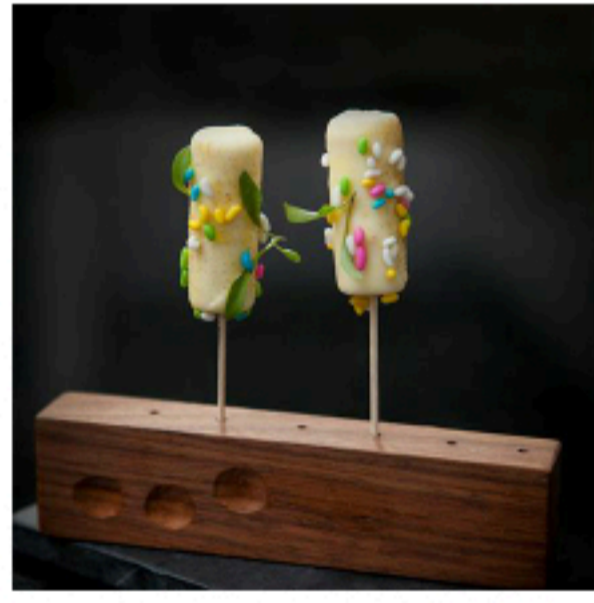

Alan Donaldson

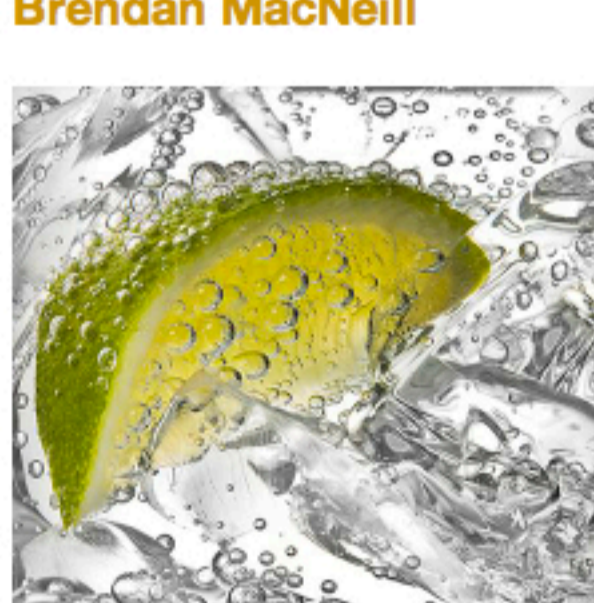
