

## THE ADA NATIONAL NETWORK

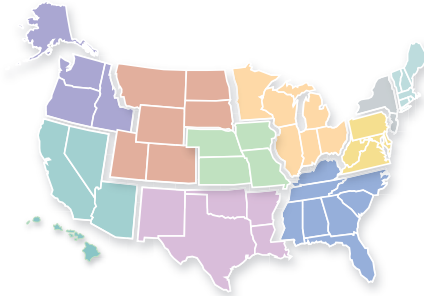

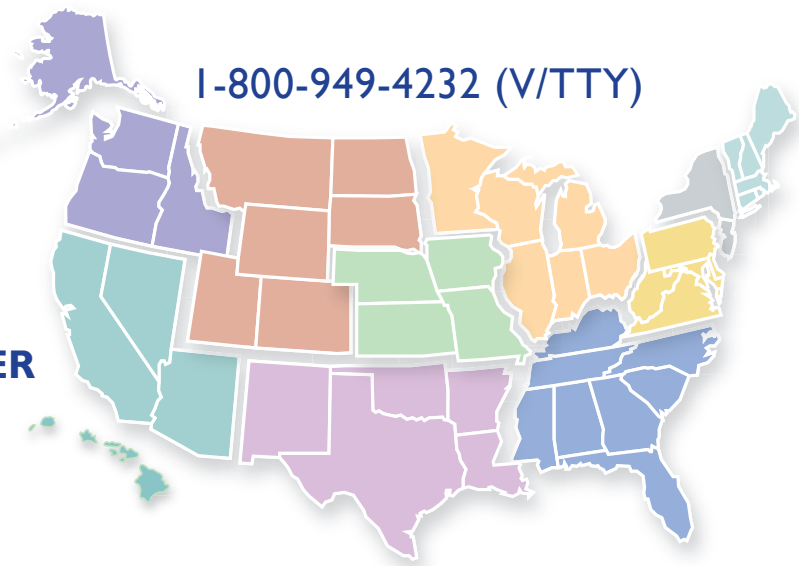
