### 1. Minutes of the Meeting 28 January 2020

After correction, the minutes were found to be a correct account of the meeting. Proposed MM, Seconded CH. Unanimously agreed.

# 2. Matters Arising

2.2.8 After further discussion about signposting, it was agreed that 6 signs were needed, including 2 to guide visitors on the path from Achnacroish. Gaelic would be necessary only on the sign at the entrance to INM. CH would investigate the possibility of weather boarding and the use of phone-readable coding.

No decision had been reached about using Bord na Gaidlig funding for bilingual signs.
