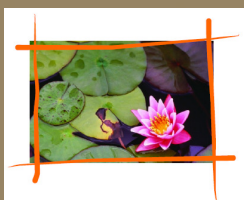

<b>Dea del Mare</b>	
Well balanced on the palate, with notes of spices, morello cherry and pain d'epices.	

<b>FRANCE</b>

A great example of this fully flavoured fruity, spicy wine that also shows great style and elegance. Well worth a try!
