Reptile and Amphibian Fencing?

Reptile fencing is one of the terms used for a wildlife barrier to keep lizards, slow worms, newts and other amphibians out of a designated area.

Reptile fencing is used as a key part in trapping the animals within the areas it encloses to enable site clearance and preparation for construction.


There are variations in the specifications for wildlife barriers, they all follow a similar form; the base of the fence needs to be buried in a shallow trench.

The basic fence structure tends to be made up of polythene sheet supported by wooden stakes at regular points as the preferred system of reptile fence construction.

Akita Fencing Install Two Main Different Types Of Fencing.

A temporary fence (normally green or clear), which can be used for drift fencing.

Or a permanent and more durable black fencing with a life expectancy of five years plus.
