As a guideline Powered Pallet Truck training should be refreshed every 3-5 years (as recommended by the Health and Safety Executive) but some discretion should be exercised to maintain competency and ensure safety.

Clients should make manufacturer instructions for the Lift Truck available to the instructor for Pump Truck training. Training for a Pallet Jack license on-site offers the advantage that the course can be tailored to your own equipment and operational requirements. The outcome is that Pallet Truck certification training is relevant to your company.
