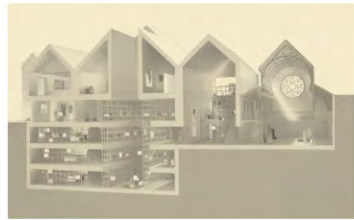

Dorset County Museum is home to astonishing collections of archaeology, geology, social history, literature and the arts, some of which contain artefacts of international significance.

The importance of these collections is behind the plan to transform the Museum into one of the leading regional museums in the country, and the heart of Dorset's cultural life.

We are expanding the Museum to create new galleries, storage and conservation areas and a dedicated learning centre.

This project will make the Museum even better for everyone who wants to explore, enjoy and care for its treasures.



A LOCAL TREASURE

Creating Tomorrow's Museum for Dorset will cost £14.9 million. Through the Heritage Lottery Fund, national lottery players are supporting the project with a grant of over £11.34m. We have raised £2.34m ourselves, leaving £1.1m left to secure.

The decision to close the building during this exciting redevelopment has meant seeking alternative accommodation for our offices. These will be located in The Old Warehouse in Durngate Street in central Dorchester - less than 3 minutes' walk from the main Museum site.

Importantly, as part of the move to The Old Warehouse we are also including a Society Member's Room. Opening on 1st October, this will include a range of the most used books and journals from the library lending collections for Members to access, as well as a reading and research area where other items from the library collection can be produced for reference upon prior request. The Member's Room will be open from Monday to Friday, 10am–4pm and tea and coffee will be available for visiting Members free of charge.
