 Rose Community Foundation's key program achievements in 2011 were in three areas. DONOR DEVELOPMENT: Rose Community Legacy Circle has grown to include 50 planned gifts and 20 new gifts and eight new advised funds were established. FUND DISTRIBUTIONS: Donor's recommended grants totaled \$1,291,000 to a broad range of community interests. ENDOWMENT SERVICES: Two new nonprofit endowment funds were established and the Foundation paid out \$3,969,000 to local nonprofit organizations who have established permanent endowments and designated funds at the Foundation.

 Rose Foundation (EIN #84-0418124), a supporting organization of Rose Community Foundation, makes grants in five primary issue areas within the seven-county Denver community. A total of \$8,544,000 in unrestricted funds was awarded in 2011 as follows: AGING \$1,539,000 to support services for older adults, including transportation, direct services, and end-of-life care; CHILD & FAMILY DEVELOPMENT- \$1,523,000 to support early childhood development and education, family self-sufficiency and related public policy efforts; EDUCATION- \$1,627,000 to improve K-12 teacher quality and support systemic changed aimed at closing education gaps; HEALTH- \$1,346,000 to support access to care, cost-effectiveness in health care, health policy initiatives and primary prevention; JEWISH LIFE- \$2,509,000 to help strengthen connections between individuals and the Jewish community, promote Jewish growth and learning, strengthen organizations and develop leaders.
