When you use Colourstart Passport for the first time, you answer 6 simple YES or NO questions to SCREEN whether it is OK for you to use the Colourstart Patch Test. You can answer the questions whenever it's convenient for you, for example, straight after creating your account, **but at least 7 days before** your colour appointment (so that there is enough time to send out the Colourstart Patch if you need it)



Depending on your answers, Colourstart Passport will instantly send you: EITHER: an amber tick, which means you should use the Colourstart Patch Test before your colour appointment, OR: a red cross, which means you should NOT use the Colourstart Patch Test or colour your hair. Please **share your result** with us, whatever it is, using your Passport page


