To note...

- If an event or activity has this symbol next to it, it means that you can bring the person you care for along to the event. However the person you care for must be over the age of 18. Please be aware that you will be responsible for the wellbeing of the person you care for while on an event.
- IMPORTANT Some of our sessions and trips require you to book a place, this is essential as we can keep you updated should there be any changes to the event (venue & times).

Due to the popularity of our trips we allocate carers places depending on the below criteria...

- If a carer is new to our service.
- If a carer has attended a similar trip or activity before.
- If a carer is referred by one of our carers contact workers as a priority due to having a high level of need.
- If all of the above has been considered and we are still oversubscribed, carers will be picked out randomly.

We make every effort to make sure all our registered carers have an opportunity to attend our events and activities.
