

NunatuKavut Business Registry: Guidelines for Membership

This document will act as an official guideline to determine membership under the NunatuKavut Business Registry. All businesses with NunatuKavut owners or co-owners are entitled and encouraged to register with the NunatuKavut Business Centre (NBC).

There are three eligible tiers of membership through the NunatuKavut Business Registry; the explanation, incentives and required documents are detailed below:

Note: Memberships must be valid at the date of registration and will be checked annually as part of the registered business audit. Verification of memberships will be completed through the NunatuKavut Community Council membership department.

Gold Membership

Eligibility: Business must be majority owned (greater than 50%) by a NunatuKavut member or members.

Benefits of Gold Membership:

- *Provide information on bidding opportunities within Labrador.*
- *Highlighted a minimum of once per year through Nunacor/NBC media outlets.*
- *Reduced rate on Komatik Conference Room and the Nunacor Conference Room space rentals.*
- Access to CAS, NET, SEA and TBDG funding programs.
- Business Development Sessions – Businesses will be made aware of and invited to participate in sessions/webinars/training through the NBC.
- Marketing Incentives – Members have an opportunity to receive free marketing through the NBC. Free marketing opportunities may include:
 - Ads created by the NBC to be posted in various media outlets.
 - Ads published at YRADS.
- Partnership opportunities with Nunacor and its strategic partners, pending scope of work and demand.
- Partnership opportunities with other NunatuKavut Registered Indigenous Businesses.

Silver Membership

Eligibility: Business must be 50% owned by a NunatuKavut member or members.

Benefits of a Silver Membership:

- Access to CAS, NET, SEA and TBDG funding programs.
- Business Development Sessions – Businesses will be made aware of and invited to participate in sessions/webinars/training through the NBC.
- Marketing Incentives – Members have an opportunity to receive free marketing through the NBC. Free marketing opportunities may include:
 - Ads created by the NBC to be posted in various media outlets.
- Partnership opportunities with Nunacor and its strategic partners, pending scope of work and demand.
- Partnership opportunities with other NunatuKavut Registered Indigenous Businesses.

Bronze

Eligibility: Business must be minority owned (less than 50%) owned by a NunatuKavut member or members.

A Bronze NunatuKavut Registered Indigenous Business will have access to the following benefits:

- Access to funds to benefit Indigenous employees.
- Business Development Sessions – Businesses will be made aware of and invited to participate in sessions/webinars/training through the NBC.

Registration Process:

1. Complete online registration form www.nunacor.com
2. Complete business registry checklist (Business Advisor)
3. Complete Ownership Verification Form (entrepreneur)
4. Upon registration business will receive a Certificate.
5. Upon Annual review, business will receive window decal.
