Meole set early pace

Meole Brace have set the early pace in the Salop Leisure Shropshire Premier Bowling League by winning 4 out of their first 5 games. Two derbies against their nearest rivals were negotiated successfully as they beat Castlefields 9-5 and then Hanwood 12-2 before getting 4 at Wem, 10 at home to Bowring and then winning away 9-5 at Hanmer. Wem USC are just behind in 2nd after winning 3 of their 5 home games, including a 13-1 hammering of Hanmer. They also got a good 5 at Ifton after an indifferent start when they only beat Chester Road 8-6 at home and then got 3 at St Georges. Burway are level with Wem after an incredible whitewash over the reigning champions Sir John Bayley, the first ever given to a defending champion. They also won their first two home games 10-4 against Wrockwardine Wood and Chester Road to give them a good start at home. St Georges are also locked on 39 points in 2nd after overcoming a slow start from tough trips to Hanwood and Newport. They won 9-5 at Chester Road and then thrashed Wrockwardine Wood at home 13 -1. Castlefields and Bowring are just behind on 38 points, with the Fields earning a fine 8-6 win at Hanmer as well as good home results against Ifton and Burway 10-4 and 11-3 respectively. Bowring have had a sold start with a couple of 10-4 home wins and a 9-5 against the Bayley on the opening night. They also got a good 5 at Chester Road and 4 at Meole Brace. Hanwood have earned three good 11-3 wins at home but only scoring 3 away has restricted them to just 38 points to.

Despite their whitewash, the Bayley are on 37 points after a great win at Ifton 10-4 and two 11-3 wins at home to Newport and Hanwood. Ifton did earn two wins in their other home games with a 11-3 win over Newport and a 9-5 against Wem USC. They also got a good 4 at Castlefields and 5 at Bylet. Newport pushed on from only getting 3 in their first two away matches to have good home wins over St Georges and Chester Road, as well as 4 at Wrockwardine Wood. Wrockwardine also had a good 12-2 win against Hanmer at home but only 1 at St Georges and 3 at Hanwood has kept them near the bottom end. Chester Road have had a slow start with a home defeat to St Georges and only beating Bowring 9-5 at home. Hanmer have had a tough start in their debut season after beating Bylet 12-2 first game, losing at home to Castlefields and Meole Brace and only getting 3 points in total from their first two away games, so find themselves bottom. Bylet recovered from those 2 winners to defeat Burway 12-2 and Ifton 9-5 at home to have a good start.



Roden first SJB Winner

Tom Roden (pictured above) won the 2017 No Bull Apparel Shropshire Premier Bowling League Merit at Craven Arms to become the first Sir John Bayley bowler to do so. He beat former home player Wayne Rogers of Burway in the final 21-9 after a day where he utilised one straight mark effectively in all of his games, as well as being equal to whatever his opponent threw at him. He was always comfortable despite an early 3-0 deficit as a 12 break in the corners helped him to a 12-3 lead and he never looked back after as he beat some good bowls of Wayne's when he had the block. Wayne had recovered from 12-3 down against Hanmer's Gary Whitehall in the Semi Finals in the corners to run 13 on him and win 15. Tom had a good run himself in the corners from 6 across to lead 14-6 and maintain that advantage till the end, getting out 12 against Hanwood's Ash Wellings, who was very impressive all day.
