

The HelpKidzLearn Games and Activities website has an extensive collection of ready made, accessible learning activities. They address a range of skills including attending, sensory exploration, cause and effect, turn taking, language and communication, early literacy, early numeracy, errored and errorless choice making, fact finding, problem solving, timing, tracking, turn taking, 2 player cooperation, creativity, and more.

Low-Tech Solutions

Visual Schedules

Create picture schedules for your students and have them visible throughout the day, always available for students to reference.

Create a visual schedule for the whole class, and display it on the wall or whiteboard. Or create an

individual schedule for a student, and display it by his or her desk area, cubby, iPad, wheelchair, etc.

Refer to the schedule as you complete activities, helping students follow along with the schedule

Visual schedules have various benefits for students

- -establish independence
- -connect abstract to real (especially prepositional concepts like "before" "after" "next", etc.)
- -reduced anxiety about what is coming
- -help refocus on task had hand by recognition that specific time is allocated to specific activities





Classroom Community Book

Here at Inclusive we love the idea of community, and believe that students are better off when they feel like they're part of one. There are plenty of things you can do to make your class room feel more like a community. One idea is to create a book about the individual members of that community - your students!

Assign students their own page with a picture of themselves and information about them. Include whatever information you want - nicknames, favorite food, favorite game, favorite tv show, fun fact, etc.,

Make the book a play on popular stories, such as "Ms. B's class, Ms. B's class, what do you see? I see looking at me". Use each page for each student in the class, being sure to also include a picture.

Let students take their own pictures for the book! See *It's So APPlicable* to see how switch users can take selfies too.

Connect your APPlicator to an iDevice and easily program it to convert a switch press to the Volume Up command. Did you know that the Volume Up button on your iDevice will take a picture when the camera is open? Turn your kids into photographers with just the press of a switch!

Students will love taking the photographs themselves and making their additions to a Classroom Community Book or CM3 classroom community activity. Each student can snap a selfie of themselves to use as the picture for their page!





Communication Corner


Ideas for using different switch communicators in back to school activities




Communication between educators and parents is so important. Start out strong by employing an easy and consistent method of communicating. Record a message into to SmoothTalker telling parents about the student's school day, and parents can record a message back about the evening or weekend. This way it's easy for both educators and teachers to stay informed about both school and home life.




The beginning of the year means a new schedule, which can be overwhelming to some students. Program a student's schedule into the SmoothTalker, so they can follow along as the day progresses or just remind themselves of the sequence of events.



Use the SmoothTalker with both verbal and nonverbal students as a tool for learning their classmates names. Program in the names of each student in the class, then press the SmoothTalker to say a name. Students must then identify that student. Take it a step further and have students tell fun facts about each other. Get creative!



Students respond well to having a voice in their classroom environment. When students play a role in developing the rules, they're more likely to take ownership of them. While some rules are nonnegotiable, others are up for debate. Let students vote on suggested rules. That could vote "yes" or "no" on specific rules, or they could vote for their preference between two similar rules.



Program in social scripts for classmates to use together. This can be great for students to not only get to know a little bit about each other, but also to practice engaging with one another. Practicing social skills and turn taking sets the tone for the year and help establish cooperative and positive relationships between classmates.



Program in the names of each student in the class. The SmoothTalker user can participate in beginning of the year gettingto-know-you activities and identifying their classmates by name.
