Remember that legislation, case law, and advances in technology may alter the way that certain investigative procedures are carried out and documented, and legal requirements must be adhered to at all times.

It is recommended that you use the framework throughout your online investigation to ensure that all measures are taken to document the steps taken, keywords utilized, and websites visited, in addition to any pertinent information that was uncovered during each step of your internet research or investigation.
