Small Groups

Small groups meet regularly to build friendship and "do life together". They typically follow the Sunday teaching series but do have the freedom to look at a biblical topic or a book. Members of these groups may, and often do, leave their Small Group for a while in order to join a Course Group and then return to their Small Group later.



Activity Groups

These groups bring together people with shared interests in sports, hobbies or skills.



Course Groups

These groups gather around a curriculum, like Alpha, Freedom in Christ, Marriage or Parenting for example. People may leave a Community Group for a period to join a Course Group and then return to their Community Group.



Reach Groups

Groups that are involved in social action projects, outreach or serving the local community. These can be ongoing or short term groups that form and then disperse.

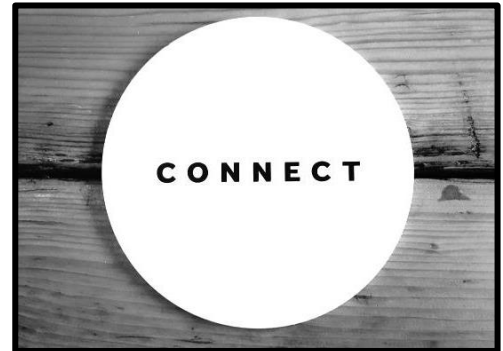

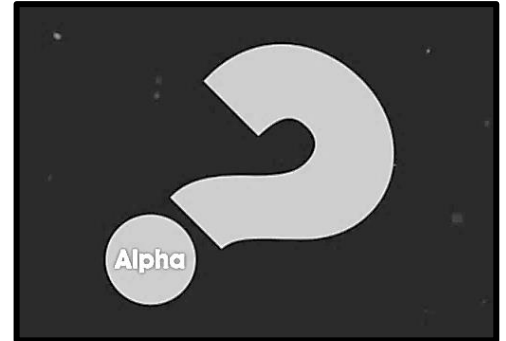

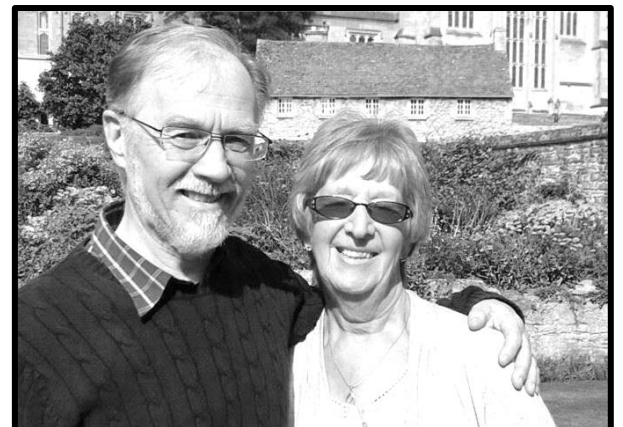
