



Aberdeenshire Farmer Gets Into 'In Vessel Compost-

Gray Composting Services was set up by Charlie Gray to service the fish processing plants around the Portsoy and Fordyce area of Aberdeenshire. Before the introduction of the Animal By Product Regulation Mr Gray had some experience in composting of shellfish waste on his farms. However with the introduction of the ABP regulation Mr Gray started to look for a proven process alternative. After contacting his local Chamber of Commerce for assistance and researching the market for technologies, Mr Gray decided to opt for the VCU technology

"We chose the VCU in-vessel composting system as our preferred technology for its proven track record in animal by-product processing," said Charlie. "VCU were also extremely supportive and knowledgeable in assisting with both our successful planning application and Waste Management Licence." As of August 2007 Gray Composting have achieved positive release from the SVS and at this years RWM show, will be negotiating for a further two chambers, for which they have been awarded WRAP funding.
