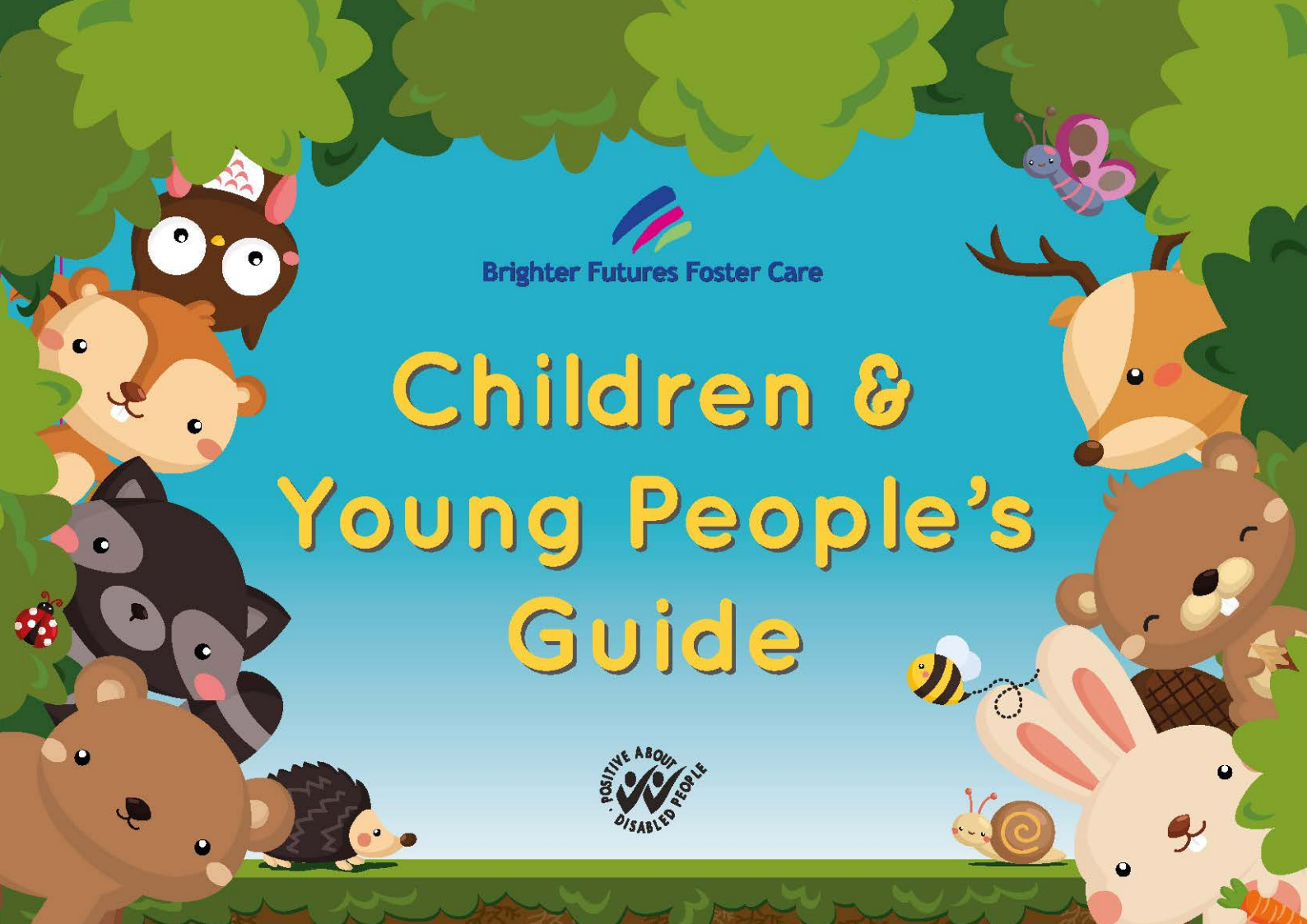

Worried

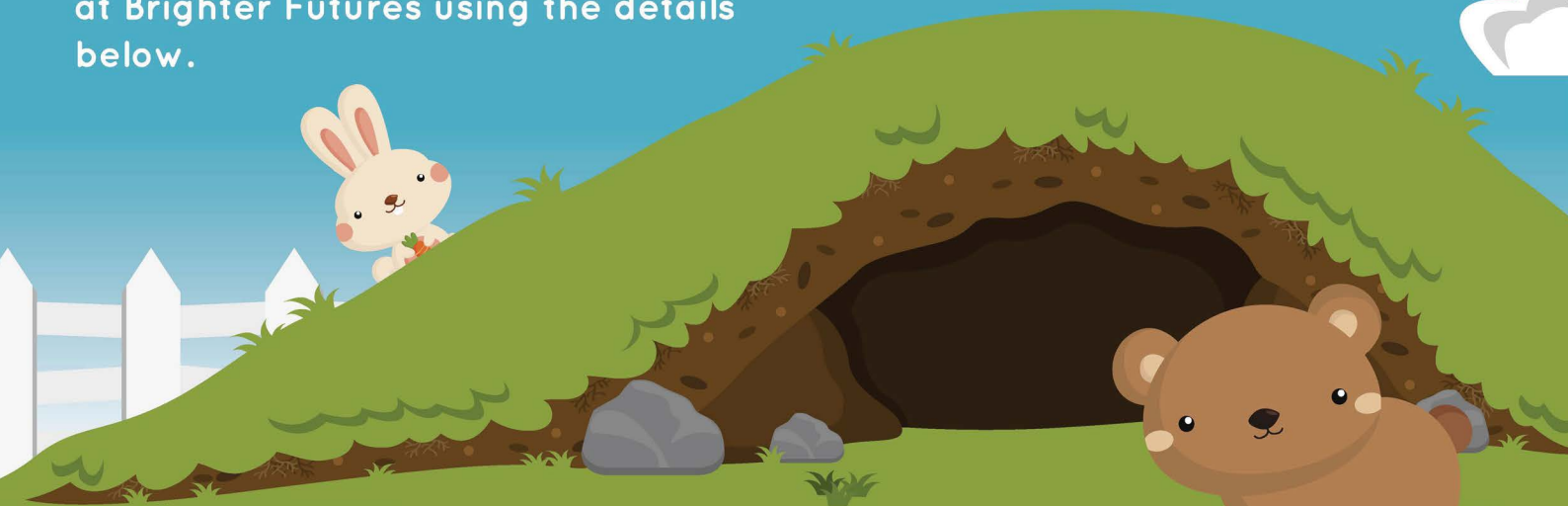

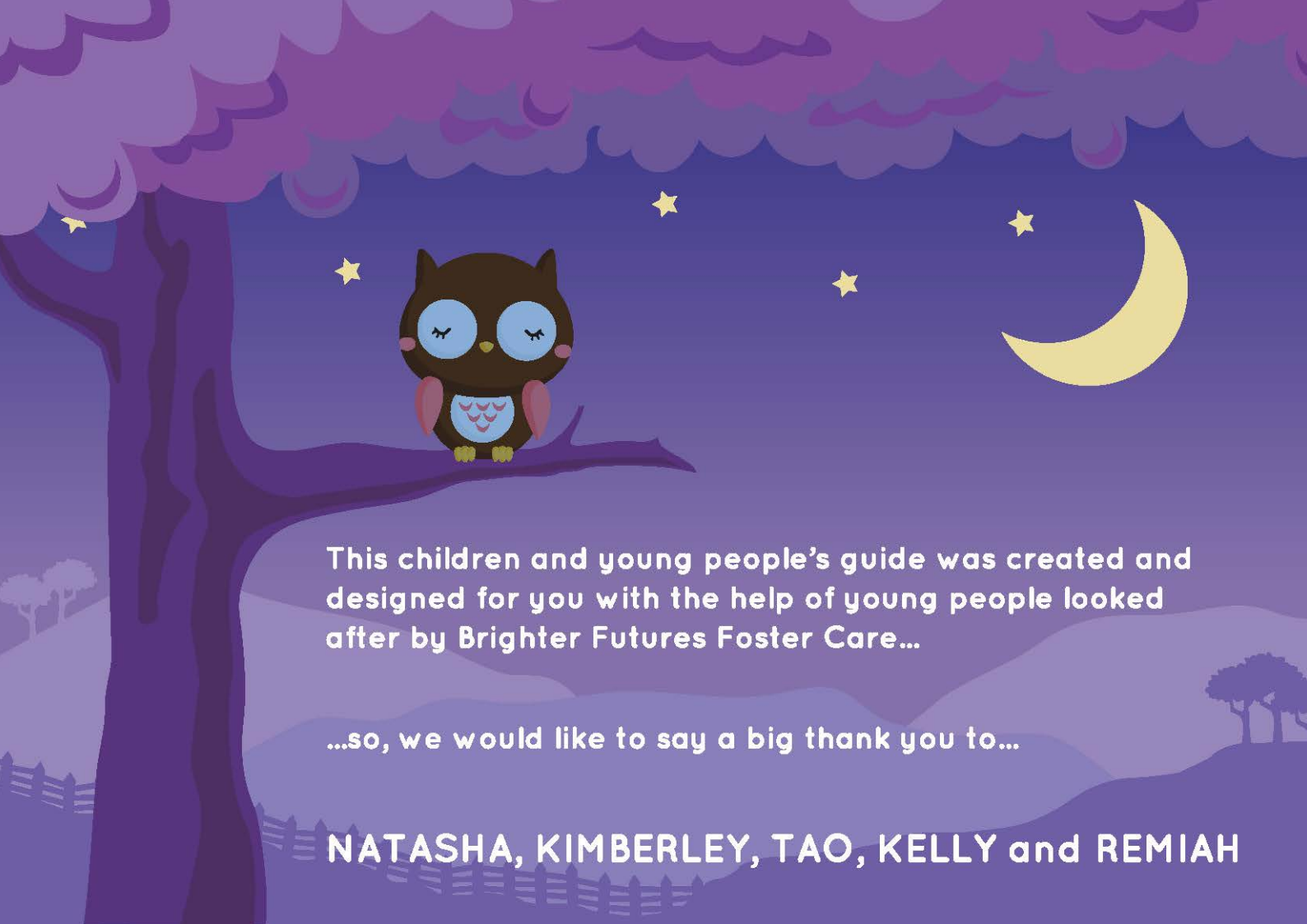
