GENICULAR NERVE BLOCK What is a genicular nerve block?

A genicular/articular nerve block is a great way for your provider to determine if painful knee arthritis will respond to genicular or articular nerve ablation. During the nerve block, you will be injected with a local anesthetic around the nerves of the hip or knee, blocking the nerves that transmit pain. If pain is successfully alleviated, you may be a strong candidate for a nerve ablation.

Who is it for?

If you suffer from the following, a genicular/articular nerve block may be right for you:


- Severe Osteoarthritis
