CLIFF'S NOTES

Recently Greenhouse Ministries was able to donate a car to a woman who was walking over a mile to work, one way. When I first took her to see her car she threw her hands up and hollered, "lawdy, lawdy, lawdy! Is this really mine?" With tears in her eyes she threw her arms around me and gave me a big hug saying, "thank you, thank you, thank you." I told her to thank God, He is the provider.

Let me tell you the "rest of the story." Lucy* has been a client of Greenhouse for years and she recently came to Greenhouse to get some food. When I passed by where she was waiting to see a counselor, I asked if she was still making biscuits at one of the fast food places. She told me that she was, but she was having to walk across town before daylight because the transmission in her vehicle had gone out. She was waiting until she got enough money to buy transmission fluid. She had someone who could fix the transmission if she could just provide the fluid. I told her not to buy any fluid because I had just received a call that a business was donating a skid of transmission fluid and antifreeze. She could come pick it up the following Tuesday. She was elated.

When she returned, we got her eight quarts of transmission fluid. When we asked where her vehicle was so we could load it for her, she answered, "oh, I am walking, but I brought some strong bags." We had a big laugh together at the picture of what was happening.

A couple of days later, on "Dawn in the Morning" on Moody Radio, I shared this story and explained how God had provided before the need was even known. That afternoon I received a call from a man who "happened" to be driving through Smyrna going to Atlanta when he heard the radio program. After asking some questions about what we do at Greenhouse he said he had an automobile he would like to donate to Lucy* if that would be possible. Of course!! When he brought the car to Greenhouse Ministries, it was a very clean, low mileage, Buick Century. He even donated enough money to put new shock absorbers on the car. ALL WERE BLESSED!!

To me there is nothing more exciting than seeing God work in the lives of people. At Greenhouse we get to see it happen daily. I pray that we will all become more aware of how He is always moving to bless His people. He is utterly amazing!
