LIHBCDC plans to break ground for the homes on May 23 at 11 a.m.

"It's wonderful for our organization to be recognized with this award, which was made possible by the generosity of CA Technologies and the members of the Long Island Builders Institute," said LIHBCDC president Tom Datre. "Our mission to build new homes for returning veterans can only be accomplished with community support. To complete this task and allow us to continue to improve the lives of returning veterans and their families requires the generosity of businesses and individuals on Long Island."

To participate in the program, military veterans need to write a letter detailing military service history, present living status, employment status and why this program would change his or her life. Letters should be sent to Lois Fricke, director of development of LIHBCDC, 1757-58 Veterans Memorial Hwy, Islandia, N.Y. 11749. Applications for the Veterans Way subdivision must be received by May 16, 2013. Veterans also may be eligible for additional homes that will be constructed on Long Island in the future.
