Expert Tips to Get the Right Information to the Right Place at the Right Time

eveloping a sound data and document management strategy can truly be a challenge; the types and amount of data and documents are constantly evolving while the need for information is greater than ever. Companies are also demanding accelerated efficiencies in back-office operations to automate business processes and keep IT costs to a minimum. It has become a balancing act to organize and control the processing, storage, and delivery of structured and unstructured information. The bottom line is this: All data needs to be readily available — in the right place, at the right time, for the right people.

To take control of their information, companies need to implement solutions that provide data accessibility and maintenance to enable business processing and informed decision making and to help satisfy legal reporting requirements and compliance mandates. However, implementing such solutions shouldn't affect operational performance or incur significant costs.

There is a wide variety of software available to help companies juggle cost, performance, and compliance when managing data. So, how can SAP customers keep up with these myriad technologies and approaches and find the right solution that will help their organization efficiently manage data? And how can they be assured that the solutions are scalable and sustainable?

Start with Data Archiving

Successfully managing data must start at its creation and follow it through when it is obsolete and no longer needs to be retained to meet regulatory requirements. For companies that are dealing with a large amount of data, data archiving should be the foundation of their information lifecycle management (ILM) strategy. Archiving helps control data growth in the online database and translates to productivity gains (less data means faster performance) and cost reductions (with less data to maintain, companies can switch to a lighter, streamlined infrastructure). According to Gartner, the need for more ERP functionality has also led to a greater need for archiving, since the amount of data

that SAP systems create typically grows approximately 5% to 10% with each successive release.¹

To help a company with its archiving process, Dolphin takes a holistic approach, analyzing a company's business, technical, and functional needs to enable the organization to create a comprehensive data archiving strategy. Such a strategy should include transparent access and retrieval capabilities for seamless business use. It should also include plans for retention management and end-of-life data disposal; legacy decommissioning to maintain a lean and cost-efficient infrastructure; and storage that balances the business value of data with cost.

Dolphin also helps companies implement nearline storage solutions in both SAP ERP applications and SAP NetWeaver Business Warehouse (SAP NetWeaver BW) environments. Another important part of an ILM strategy is comparing the cost of data storage with the value of data. Dolphin

In addition, Dolphin CAS for Cloud 2.0 is SAP-certified as SAP Solution Manager Ready.

With this cloud solution, companies pay only for the storage space they use because the solution provides a direct connection to major public cloud providers, such as AT&T Synaptic Storage as a Service, Amazon S3, Google Cloud, and others. It's an option that makes sense for any organization, whether or not it plans on running other SAP solutions in the cloud. The lower cost of storage and the increased efficiency that cloud storage brings, as well as the improved system performance of a data warehouse unencumbered by older data, translates into sustainable cost reductions.
