ADOPTION CONTRACT

CODE OF ADOPTION

Every care is taken to ensure that the animal you take home is in good health and we are happy to offer any advice that you may need. You are advised to register your adopted pet with your own veterinary surgeon at your earliest convenience.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL VETERINARY COSTS FROM DATE OF ADOPTION.

In consideration of you agreeing to the following stipulations (and acknowledging that this adoption contract is conditional on you so doing), we hereby consent to you adopting the dog on the terms of this Contract:

- To take good care of the dog and not part with him/her to any other person or body. You acknowledge that you have no entitlement to transfer the dog to any third party and any attempt to do so will not pass ownership of the dog to that third party and will expose you to a claim for damages for any costs incurred in recovering the dog. If the dog is not wanted for ANY reason it must be returned to West Yorkshire Dog Rescue at the owner's expense. We will receive the dog back at the earliest opportunity, but at our convenience when we have a suitable foster available.
- As new custodian of the dog, to be responsible for all veterinary charges and treatment that the dog may require and indemnify West Yorkshire Dog Rescue against all liabilities.
- To keep the dog fully vaccinated at all times by means of an annual booster and treated for worms and fleas under the advice of a qualified Veterinary Surgeon.
- Under no circumstances to allow the dog to be kept outside or live in an outside building.
- Not to allow the dog to roam free or worry livestock, thereby causing a nuisance.
- In the event that the dog goes missing to take all practicable steps to find him/her as soon as possible and to inform West Yorkshire Dog Rescue, dog warden and police.
- If the dog is not neutered, to get this done at the earliest opportunity under veterinary guidance, we will follow up to ensure this happens.
- To allow a representative of the West Yorkshire Dog Rescue to visit the dog at the owner's home and check on its welfare at any time. In the event that our representative decides that the conditions in which the dog is kept and/or his/her state of health and welfare are not satisfactory; or if the dog is not neutered, to allow us to reclaim the dog.
- To notify West Yorkshire Dog Rescue of any change of address where the dog lives.
- To make full provision should the dog be left unsupervised, and to ensure proper care when going on holiday.

It is acknowledged that should you fail to comply with the above terms or if West Yorkshire Dog Rescue considers it to be in the best interest of the dog, you will allow us to reclaim the dog. We make no guarantee of the temperament or behaviour of the dog, and dogs can change behaviour in the new home. .
